You didn't even have Mrs. Moglenicky pressuring you with her suspicious side-eye glance in the second grade (I wasn't a bad kid; I just had an active mind, and apparently Mrs. Moglenicky did not understand my genius. Staring out into space was obviously how I did my best work.). So are you sure about what you're saying? In a culture of posts, pundits and personalities yelling, 'Look at me!!'
