The crucifix and in this candle photograph are reflections from the Chapel. The photograph shows

the Crucifix of the chapel framing the right side and top of St. Jude's head. The crease in the clothing of the St. Jude image is just below the crucifix making it look like blood is flowing from the crucifix onto St. Jude.



The image of St. Jude that was on display in the Church was created specifically for the St. Jude Relic Tour of the States United which began in September 2023 and runs to May of 2024.



It shows St. Jude with a writing tool and scroll which reflects his authorship of the New Testament Letter of St. Jude. Our parish was greatly blessed to have the relics come to St. Jude Church.
