Everyone deserves a chance and a future and knowing we are there helping brings me so much joy.

With this desire for service, I am now a Salesian Lay Missioner. I served a year in Cambodia, and now I'm doing a second year at Mary Help of Christians Academy in New Jersey teaching theology and working with Campus Ministry.



I am so excited to be going back to Nicaragua this December.

We want to bring them presents for Christmas.
