A Message of Hope

Jesus Christ paid the ultimate sacrifice for our eternal salvation. In the words of the gospel, "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends."

The simplicity of today's gospel needs little explanation because Jesus sacrificed His life for us. We may approach the Father, "so that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you." This gospel is one of many that I often refer to as fundamental to our understanding of the nature of Christ's presence in our world and in our lives. A gospel such as this contains so much of the essential truth of Jesus' mission to save the world. He also reminds us that we have been chosen by Him to continue revealing God's great love for us. The most powerful way that we can do this is to "love one another." Jesus does not commend us to do this in a superficial fashion, but rather to love one another with all our heart, with all our mind and with all our soul. In fact, in this particular gospel He commands us to do so. We owe this great depth of love to God because of His great love for us. Jesus is the manifestation of God's love acted out in salvation history.

Love is a much-misused word in our culture, but if you need a primer in what love really is, go no further than the 15th chapter of John's gospel. The power of the language, which he uses, exceeds any simple human wisdom concerning love, romantic or otherwise. The love that exists between Jesus and God the Father is transmitted directly to us through the Eucharist and so the first sentence in the gospel becomes the powerful reality of our faith life, "As the Father loves me, so I also love you."




