A Message of Hope

Dear Parishioners:

We have all participated in, or been the recipient of, a major event somewhere—sometime in our lives. It may have been an anniversary, a surprise party or perhaps a fundraising ball. Whatever it was, we all know that the principle work involved is in the *preparation*. The better the *preparation* the smoother the event will go. Even small events can require large numbers of people and hours of work. The season of Advent is our time for *preparing* for the birth of Christ. The readings, while somewhat apocalyptic in nature, are specifically chosen to heighten our awareness of the Christmas event.

On one level, our parish community uses the season of Advent to **prepare** for Christmas in ways that are charitable such as...The Giving Tree...and in ways that are prayerful such as...Advent Mass Changes; the most profound **preparation** must be in our hearts. If we put as much time and energy into preparing our hearts to receive the Lord as the retail industry does in its advertising to persuade us to spend our money, the season of Christmas would be far more balanced than it currently is. Each of us must take the time to meditate and reflect upon the mystery of God's salvation born into the world.

As we begin the season of Advent, I encourage each one of us to adequately *prepare* ourselves for His entrance into our hearts and our world. Making sure that Christ is in Christmas is the duty and responsibility of each one of us. I hope that our *Efforts...Liturgy...Prayer...* and *Charity* enhance our ability to meet Christ when He comes and refresh our hearts and souls in His service.
