In this week's Gospel, Jesus sets out on his final journey to Jerusalem. Unfortunately, He is not greeted with open arms but instead by rejection. As we know, the Samaritans and the Jews did not get along and although Jesus, being more accepting than His disciples, even He didn't truly acknowledge the rejection but instead walked on.

Listen to what happens next. These friends want to follow Jesus but Jesus does not make it easy for them. Perhaps because He knows what their lives will be like after he is gone. Radically different than anything they could have imagined. They will leave everything behind and go into a totally new and unknowing direction. We are offering three opportunities to attend and we hope at least one is convenient for your family. Thank you.




