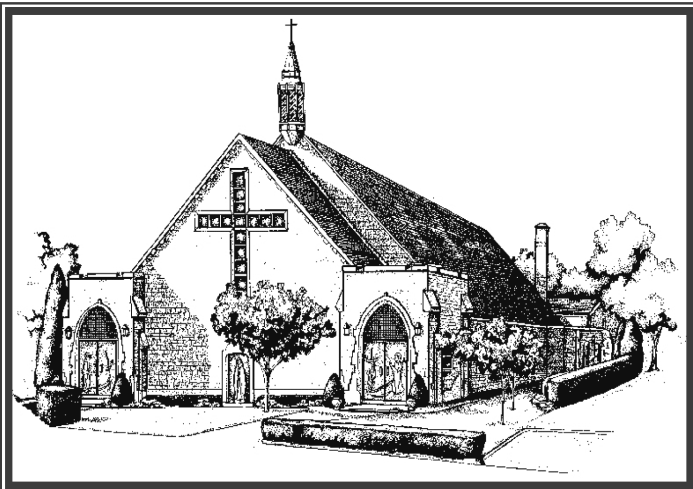

While not thinking of it, as I should have, we could have reminded them that St. James of the Marches in terrific Totowa is the only Church in the United States named after this Franciscan Friar. Being unique is beautiful!

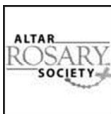

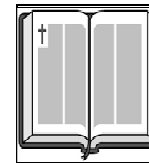
