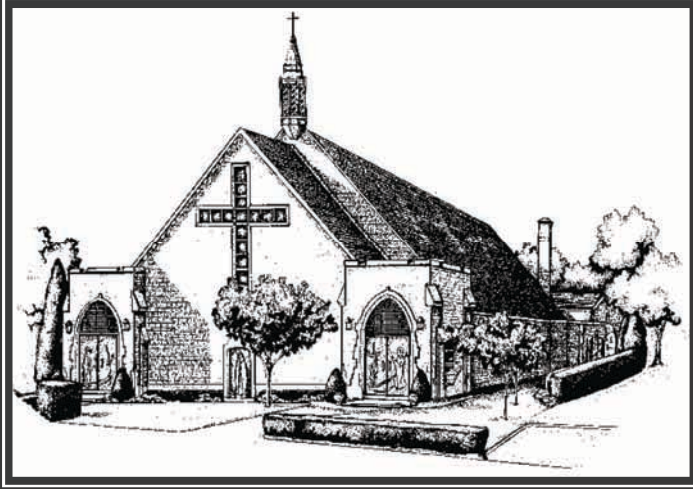

Last Sunday was a great day for St. James as we all came together in prayer to remember the victims of the 9/11 attacks by terrorists on our country and to support the Borough of Totowa's First Responders, our Firefighters, Police Officers, and First Aid Squad.

Every parish Church is a part of the community in which it is located, and every community is part of the parish which serves it. We are fortunate here in Totowa that our town leadership is responsive to the needs of its people. There is no place for bureaucracy here, and everyone knows someone in the governmental structure who can help.

Ours is a well-oiled government, where things work, thank God, and those in leadership positions have the town's best interest at heart. If something goes wrong, our leaders hear about it rather quickly, and whatever the situation might be is resolved in an expedient manner.

Everyone in our Church, present at the 10:15 am Mass, was happy to be there and proud to see our Police Officers, Firefighters, and First Aid Squad process up the aisle. All of these men and women looked particularly dignified in uniform.

If you were not present, our **Mayor, John Coiro**, did the First Reading, **Diane Emmolo**, the regularly scheduled lector, did the Second Reading, and the **Passaic County Clerk, Kristin M. Corrado, Esq.** and a graduate of our grammar school, read the Prayer of the Faithful.

We were happy to have **Robert W. Coyle**, our Police Chief, **Robert Barbieri**, President of Totowa's First Aid Squad, and **Kevin Walsh**, Church Trustee and President of Totowa's Fire Department, bring up the offertory gifts.

Parishioner **Diane Capone**, parishioner **Frank Mullen**, and **Sister Mary Cecile, C.S.JB**, our Pastoral Associate, served as Eucharistic Ministers. Because we had almost five hundred people present at Mass, Holy Communion took a little bit longer to distribute, and that is a wonderful problem to have.

The members of our Adult Choir, though few in number, sounded remarkably good. Organist, **Jeannine Pond**, and Leader of Song, **Greg Caldarone**, always enhance any Mass at which they are present. We had, as a special addition, the Second Graders of our school sing *God Bless America* for us. Kate Smith would have been proud of them.

Frank Mullen coordinated the seating of

our guests, never an easy task, and with his great patience and the partnership of our ushers, led everyone to where they should be, and **Jeff Torres** coordinated the procession of our honored guests as only Jeff can do.

The Ladies of Hospitality greeted everyone and handed out programs. Our ushers and altar servers are also to be thanked for being so committed and so professional in their service.

Those smiling ladies who made sure everyone received a program and greeted the capacity crowd were **Arlene Festa, Adelaide Fiorarancio, Linda Kowalski, and Eleanor Latka**. A special **Thank you** to them! Many of those who were present were not from this Church, and it makes a big difference to be welcomed so warmly.

Over the past few weeks, three Irishmen, **Fred Dell'Aquila, Danny Di Iorio, and Tom Romeo** have helped us on several projects, and we thank them for their generosity. (As you can see, I was never good in geography.)

Work on the convent continues to bring us closer to welcoming **Sister Ann Matthew and Sister Clare** to their new home.

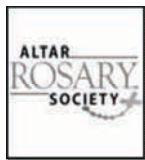

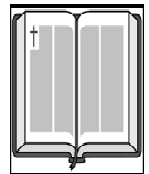

ACADEMY OF ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI
Weekend of September 17 / 18, 2016

From the desk of Sister Anne Matthew...
(Assistant Principal)

The Academy of St. Francis of Assisi has been fulfilling its mission of faith formation since 1956 when the doors opened with principal Sr. Francis Jerome and pastor, Fr. Francis Reilly. Due to the decline of vocations to religious life, our Community was withdrawn in 1977. We are assured from Scripture in the words of (saint) Paul sows the seeds, Apollo waters them, but it is God who gives the growth.

The passion of my life has always been to live and laugh, listen and learn, love and lean on the free/spontaneous World of Children-as they reflect the beauty, goodness and truth of the One Significant Other in my life. I am grateful to the Lord of history who continues to write in mysterious ways to create his own designs in each one's story! I am happy to be teaching our fifth and sixth grade religion and *believe* parents are the child's first and primary educators; we, their teachers share in this precious partnership that hopefully keeps God at the center.

I am a member the Franciscan Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart, Peekskill, NY. I feel it is great privilege to be here. Among my field of studies BA-Major: History & Minor in Education and earned Masters Degree in Administration/Supervision-Elementary Education from Fordham. Collaborative ministry is a top priority at this time in which I commit time, energy and enthusiasm for professional staff development that affects the entire community.

My experiences in religious and professional life have been varied and many. Teacher and administrator in Catholic Schools in the dioceses of Newark, Paterson and New York have been rewarding; with two brief pauses when I was called to serve our Community on the Leadership Councils in Rome, and also at our Motherhouse at Mt.
