I received many cards with different messages which clearly came from the bottom of their hearts. Let me tell you, everything good that happened here was of God, and "Mama" Mary, and the staff and you as a Parishioner. I like to quote The Magnificat, one of my favorite prayers, where Elizabeth praises the Blessed Mother, but she recognizes that everything that is happening in her is for the honor and glory of God, taken from Luke's Gospel (1:46-55)

My soul magnifies the Lord And my spirit rejoices in God my Savior; Because He has regarded the lowliness of His handmaid; For behold, henceforth all generations shall call me blessed; Because He who is mighty has done great things for me, and holy is His name; And His mercy is from generation to generation on those who fear Him. He has shown might with His arm, He has scattered the proud in the conceit of their heart. He has put down the mighty from their thrones, and has exalted the lowly. He has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich He has sent away empty. He has given help to Israel, his servant, mindful of His mercy Even as he spoke to our fathers, to Abraham and to his posterity forever.

Every day, I contemplate the huge responsibility of being a Priest. Being His face on earth. Being His hands, ears, eyes... doing His mission... giving color to others' lives, in the midst of joyful and sorrowful moments. For five years as a Priest, this is what my priesthood was, and is, about. I plant the seed; it is God who makes it grow. My priesthood makes sense just with you, God and you are the reason for my ministry. Thank you, so much, for everything, again.

Each place is different, where God places people in your life for a reason, a season or a lifetime. I have learned so much from the people in every place. This is part of the process of my life. I have enjoyed the time with you so much; I have learned from each one of you. I have gotten great experiences for my future as a priest. I am so grateful to God for all 7 months that I shared with you and all the trust that our Bishop has in me as a young priest. It was an honor and a privilege to serve the church here.

I have finished my mission here at St. James, which our diocese entrusted to me as a Temporary Administrator. I am beginning a new chapter in my life. Everything that I do is for the glory of God and "Mama" Mary. I feel Saint James is like my second home. I have found wonderful people here; many angels with a real body. I met and worked with an extraordinary staff and volunteers that are, and will always be, a rock for the church.

St Teresa of Calcutta has a quote which I feel describes me at this stage of my life. It goes something like this. "I am a little pencil in God's hands. He does the writing. The pencil has nothing to do with it. The pencil has only to be allowed to be used". Yes, I am a pencil to go wherever God wants. I am going to start a new chapter in my life. You, as a Parish, will begin a new chapter, too. Thank you, so much, for your support. You have touched my life, and I have grown.

I am very bad at saying Good Bye. I love the message that the Rosary Society gave to me, "There are many different ways to say farewell, but our favorite is "ALOHA" because it means both "goodbye" and "hello again". It has been a very short time I have been here, but you are in my heart.

I will miss you. I will continue praying for you. In my prayers I say, please, "God, I pray and bless people that I have met, for all that I know, and those that I will meet. Hear all their requests and petitions."


