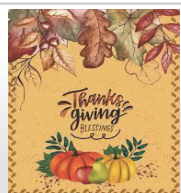

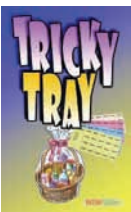

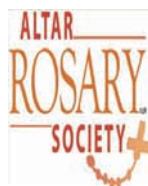
Sacrament of Baptism

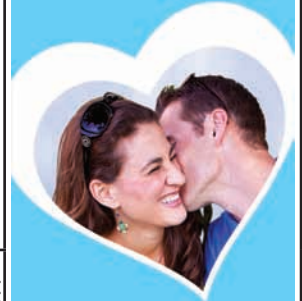
