



## **Confirmation Preparation Requirements Contract for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Candidates**

*“A candidate for Confirmation who has attained the age of reason must profess the faith, be in the state of grace, have the intention of receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation, and be prepared to assume the role of disciple and witness to Christ, both within the ecclesial (Church) community and in temporal affairs” (CCC #1319, on the Responsibilities of the Candidate for Confirmation).*

### ***Mandatory Attendance***

- **Class:** No more than 2 unexcused absences are allowed.
- **Mass:** Weekly Mass, Holy Days of Obligation, Ash Wednesday, 2 of the 6 Stations of the Cross, Easter Triduum Participation, and Easter Vigil or Easter Sunday Mass. No more than 2 unexcused absences are allowed.
- **Ceremonies:** 1<sup>st</sup> Year Students - Rite of Acceptance on Sunday, March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at the 10:15 Mass. 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Students - Rite of Candidacy on Sunday, March 20<sup>th</sup> at the 12:00 Mass and Confirmation on Friday, May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 7:00 PM.
- **Spiritual Retreat:** NET Retreat will be on Sunday, February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Students will experience a community building and personal spiritual growth.
- **Confirmation Interview & Practice (2<sup>nd</sup> Year Students):** Interview and Final test will take place on Tuesday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023 at 6:00 PM in the School Hall. Confirmation Practice will take place on Monday, May 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 PM in Church.

### ***Mandatory Self Reflections, Test and Other Papers***

- **Monthly Faith Based Essay:** Last Class of Each Month. Write a 5-10 sentence reflection essay once a month on your interpretation of a gospel/ homily that you heard in mass, a scripture that you read in the Bible, or something that interests you about our Catholic faith. How can it help you and can you incorporate what you have learned in your own life situations? Did your perspective of these certain faith lessons change with this new understanding?
- **Annual Service Project Reflection Essay:** Due May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023. Write a one page reflection essay choosing one of the service projects that you did that had the most impact on your life. How did it open your eyes to look at life a little differently? Did your perspective on this social issue change? What new skills did you learn? Describe how it helped you to be a better Catholic and practice your faith.
- **Random Preparation Tests:** To help prepare you for Confirmation & Confirmation Interview.
- **Confirmation Saint Name Form & Essay (2<sup>nd</sup> Year Students):** Due January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023. Choose a saint name that you will use during the Sacrament of Confirmation. The Confirmation Saint Name Form has more detailed information on this topic. Write a one page (7-10 sentences) reflection essay on why you chose that name and what significance it has to you. Please fill in the Confirmation Saint Name Form and hand it in with your essay.
- **Letter to the Bishop (2<sup>nd</sup> Year Students):** Information on how to write your letter to the Bishop will be handed out on Tuesday, February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023. All letters will be due by March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- **Thank You Letter to your Sponsor (2<sup>nd</sup> Year Students):** Due May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

### ***Mandatory Faith in Action Service Hours & Projects***

- **2 Years of Service:** Thirty (30) community service hours and Twenty (20) Parish hours are required to be served from 7<sup>th</sup> grade up until Confirmation. All hours must be completed before Confirmation takes place.

Use everything that you have learned throughout your faith journey and open your hearts to serve those in need. Live out your discipleship by practicing the spiritual & corporal works of mercy and the beatitudes. Share at least 1 hour with your Parents/Sponsors.
