

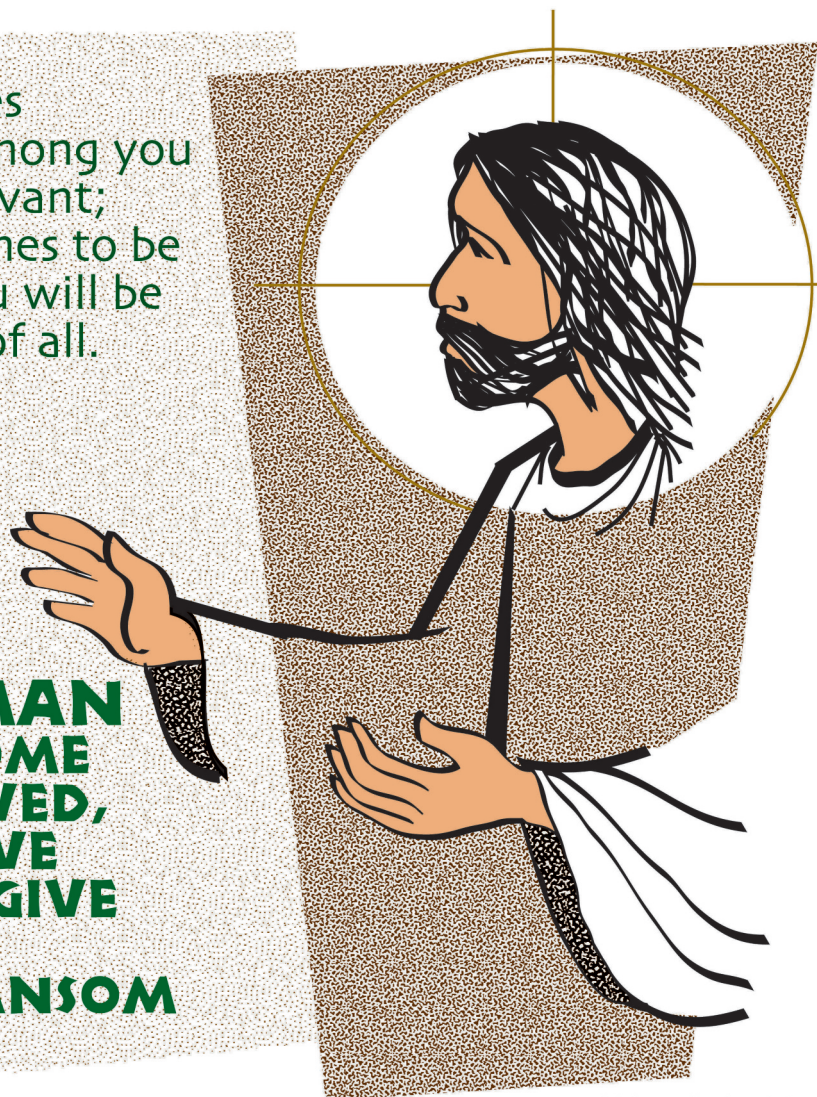

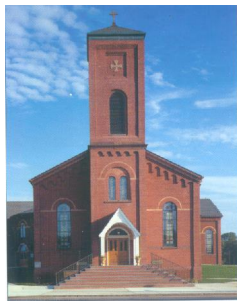

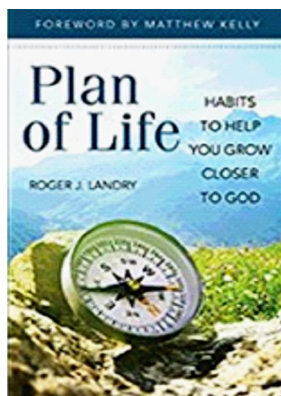

Business Manager's Report:



This week you will find the Parish Financial Report for the Fiscal Year, which ended on August 31, 2018. I would like to address some of the figures.

Regarding the Revenue Lines the increase in Parish Programs is due to our switching over to an 'Accrual Based' system of accounting which we began in Fiscal 2017, that is matching revenue with expenditures, this means revenue is recognized when earned and matched against expenditures when they are incurred. 'Auxiliary Revenue' is up since we began receiving rent on our lease of the School Building over the summer. Regular Collections we experienced a slight increase in weekly giving which we would like to thank everyone. Fund raising is up due to the inception of the 'Parish Picks' program which began last year.



On the Expense Side, the increase under 'Parish Programs' is due to having the Players put on the Play again this summer as well as the expenses incurred for our Ministry Fair which was held in May. The large increase in 'Printing & Office' is due to our paying Professional Fees for various projects, most notably paying the Real Estate Brokers their commission on the lease of the School building; as well as the Engineering Study we undertook in preparing for our

Feasibility Study and the costs associated with that. The expenses related to the lease of the School Building are one-time expenses and total \$156,423.

Maintenance and Supplies are up due to our repairs to the Clock Tower in the Church, which was offset by a generous donation. We also incurred a large expense to refurbish our Fire Alarm System. We also re-caulked the windows in the Church to eliminate water infiltration. These repairs total \$78,802.00.

If we had not incurred these expenses, we would have shown a positive of \$21,728.00 for the fiscal year that ended August 31, 2018.

I would like to thank everyone for your continued support of St. Kilian's.

The Book of Innocents:

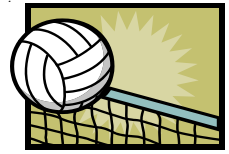

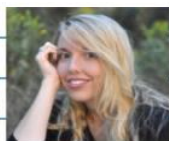

El que quiera ser grande tiene que ser servidor de todos. Gracias a Santiago y Juan, hoy podemos entender lo que esto significa. Por ejemplo, de que si se puede los santos comprendieron muy bien lo de dar la vida por otros. Santa Teresa de Calcuta lo vivió al ciento por ciento. Su legado es un tesoro para la sociedad de hoy. Reflexionemos en las siguientes frases: "La falta de amor es la mayor pobreza. Dar hasta que duela y cuando duela dar todavía más.
