Matrimony:

Marriage arrangements should be made with a deacon or priest at least six months before the proposed wedding date. No dates for marriage will be given over the

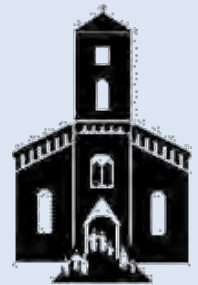

Weekday substitutes needed to work with clients. Could be any day, Monday through Thursday, from 9:00am-12:00pm. Will be trained.

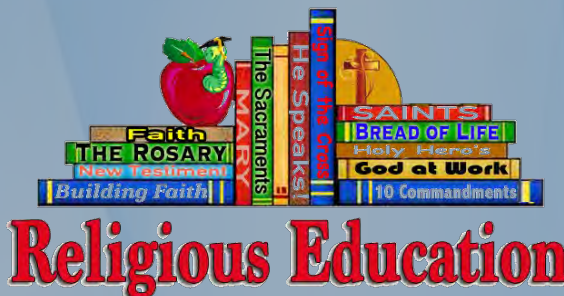

of mullagh, co cavan.

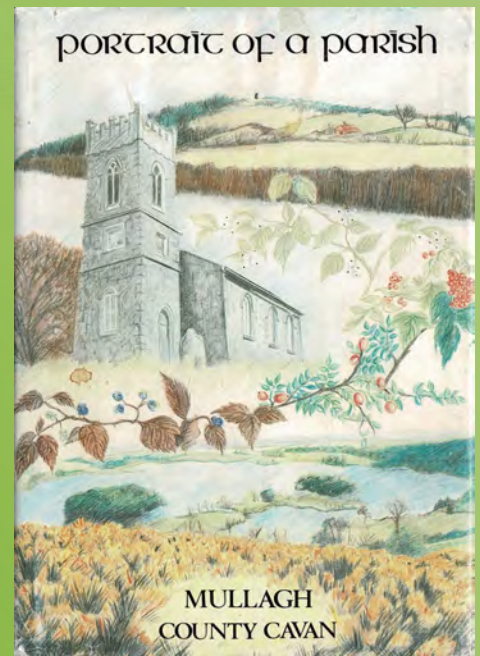
i arrived in the birthplace of s. kilian in september 2020 in the

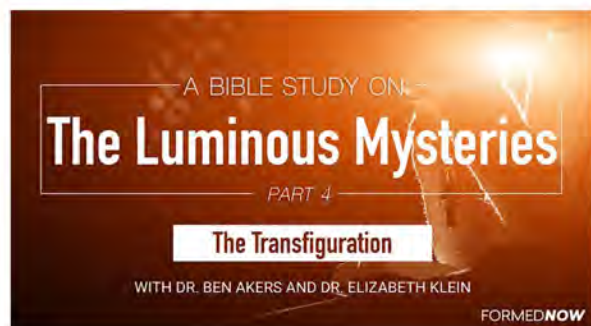
COMPANIONS IN SHIPWRECK

As Tolkien described marriage, it's all about being "companions in shipwreck."



LEARN

A BIBLE STUDY ON THE LUMINOUS MYSTERIES: THE TRANSFIGURATION



This week we celebrate the feast of the Transfiguration, the mountaintop manifestation of Christ's glory that we read about in the Gospel.
