DID YOU KNOW...?

About Mother Cabrini

A beautiful hand-carved statue of Mother

Cabrini, one of the statues from Italy recently

installed in our new shrine area in

St. Kilian Church.

Frances Xavier Cabrini, also called Mother Cabrini, was an Italian-American Roman Catholic Nun and the first U.S. citizen to be canonized in 1946. Mother Cabrini herself was an immigrant from Italy to the United States. She wanted to be a missionary to Japan, but the Pope asked her instead to go to New York to take care of all the Italian immigrants there. Mother Cabrini founded



67 institutions dedicated to caring for the poor, the abandoned, the uneducated and the sick, including the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, a Catholic religious order that was a major support to her fellow Italian immigrants to the United States.

Mother Cabrini is shown with a suitcase to represent the immigrants who came to New York and an anchor to represent the ships that brought them. The anchor is also a symbol of hope—which Mother Cabrini gave to so many in her care.

Mother Cabrini is buried under the altar of the St. Frances Cabrini Shrine in Washington Heights, New York City (701 Fort Washington Avenue). Pope Pius XII named Frances Xavier Cabrini as the patron saint of immigrants, recognizing her efforts on their behalf across America in schools, orphanages, hospitals, and prisons.

Mother Cabrini is also informally recognized as an effective intercessor of finding a parking space. As one priest explained "She lived in New York City. She understands traffic".

Mother Cabrini's Feast Day is November 13th, the anniversary of her beautification.

Candlemas, which occurs 40 days after Christmas on February 2nd, celebrates the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple. This was the day that, in keeping with Jewish law, Mary and Joseph brought the baby Jesus to the temple for the first time.
