Upcoming Changes to the Weekday Mass Schedule


- Every Wednesday, a new 12:15 Mass takes place in the Rectory Chapel followed by Eucharistic Exposition and Adoration until Benediction at 7:30pm. This is a "Silent Adoration" so that each can pray in their own way.
- Friday, July 1st, the 9:00am Mass will become 8:30am Monday thru Saturday.
- Tuesday, July 5th, the 7:00am Mass moves back to the Rectory Chapel every day, Monday thru Friday.
- Tuesday July 5th until Friday September 16th, the 8:30 Mass Monday thru Saturday will be celebrated in the Rectory Chapel as a cost saving measure so we don't have to Air Condition the entire Church for one half-hour Mass.
- Saturday October 1st, and every Saturday thereafter, the 8:30am Mass will be celebrated only on the First Saturday of each Month. This will allow us an additional time for funerals when needed.



New Mass and Adoration is here!!!

On Wednesdays at 12:15pm, we have added a new Mass!

This Mass will take place in the St. Benedict Chapel in the Rectory. Additionally, as part of the US Bishops call for a Eucharist Revival in our country, this Mass will be followed immediately by Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until 7:30pm when there will be Benediction. This entire period of Exposition and Adoration will be a SILENT ADORATION so that each person present will be able to pray in their hearts or just sit quietly as the Spirit leads them.


We have good news to share! St. Kilian's Parish is now the home of a brand new Young Adult Ministry!






-inch cubes and leave crust on


1/2 Cup of sugar




