





Upcoming Changes to the Weekday Mass Schedule


- Every Wednesday, a 12:15 Mass takes place in the Rectory Chapel followed by Eucharistic Exposition and Adoration until Benediction at 7:30pm. This is a "Silent Adoration" so that each can pray in their own way.
- Weekday morning Mass, 7am & 8:30am Mass Monday thru Saturday will be celebrated in the Rectory Chapel as a cost saving measure so we don't have to Air Condition and heat the entire Church for one half-hour Mass.
- Saturday October 1st, and every Saturday thereafter, the 8:30am Mass will be celebrated only on the First Saturday of each Month. This will allow us an additional time for funerals when needed.



New Mass and Adoration is here!!!

On Wednesdays at 12:15pm, we have added a Mass!

This Mass will take place in the St. Benedict Chapel in the Rectory. Additionally, as part of the US Bishops call for a *Eucharist Revival* in our country, this Mass will be followed immediately by Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until 7:30pm when there will be Benediction. This entire period of Exposition and Adoration will be a *SILENT ADORATION* so that each person present will be able to pray in their hearts or just sit quietly as the Spirit leads them.

Directions: Microwave the bag of potatoes for 6 minutes, then cut potatoes in half or quarters, depending on the size.

Add the corn, lemon, potatoes, sausage, butter and thyme to a large bowl. Toss together and place everything on the sheet pan with the corn standing on end and the sausage pieces sliced-side down.

Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Make a pouch using 2 sheets of aluminum foil, sealing the edges very well. Place the shrimp in the pouch and add the seafood seasoning. Add the beer and close the pouch. Place the pouch on the sheet pan, atop the sausage and vegetables. Place the sheet pan in the oven and roast until the potatoes are soft and the sausage is sizzling, 35 to 45 minutes. Remove from the oven and carefully open the shrimp pouch. Pour the pouch over the sheet pan and serve.


