After the priest visits, arrangements can be made for a Eucharistic Minister to regularly bring communion to the homebound.

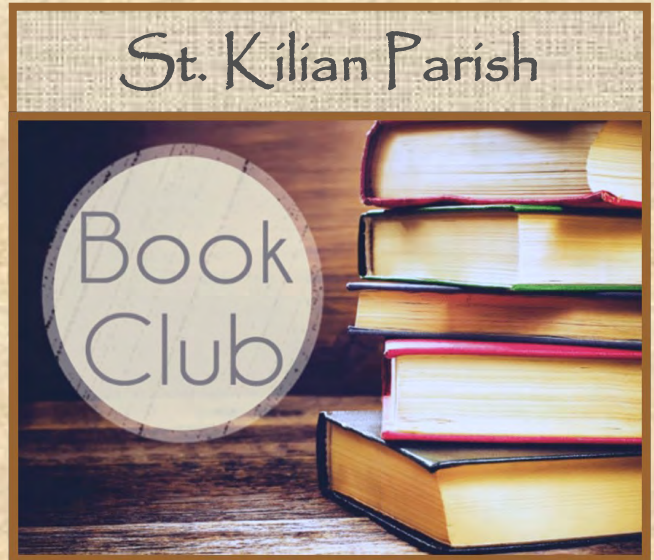
Did you Know...St. Kilian's has a Book Club?

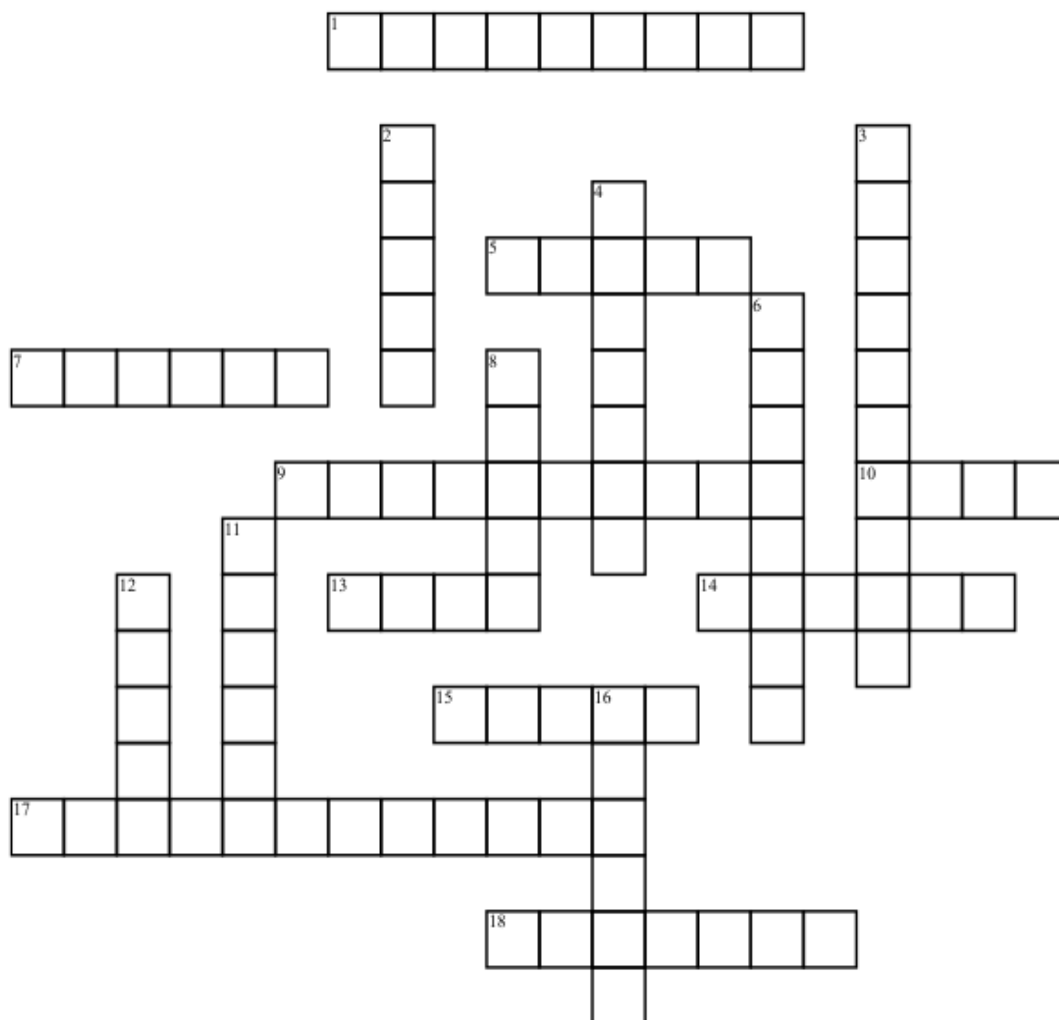

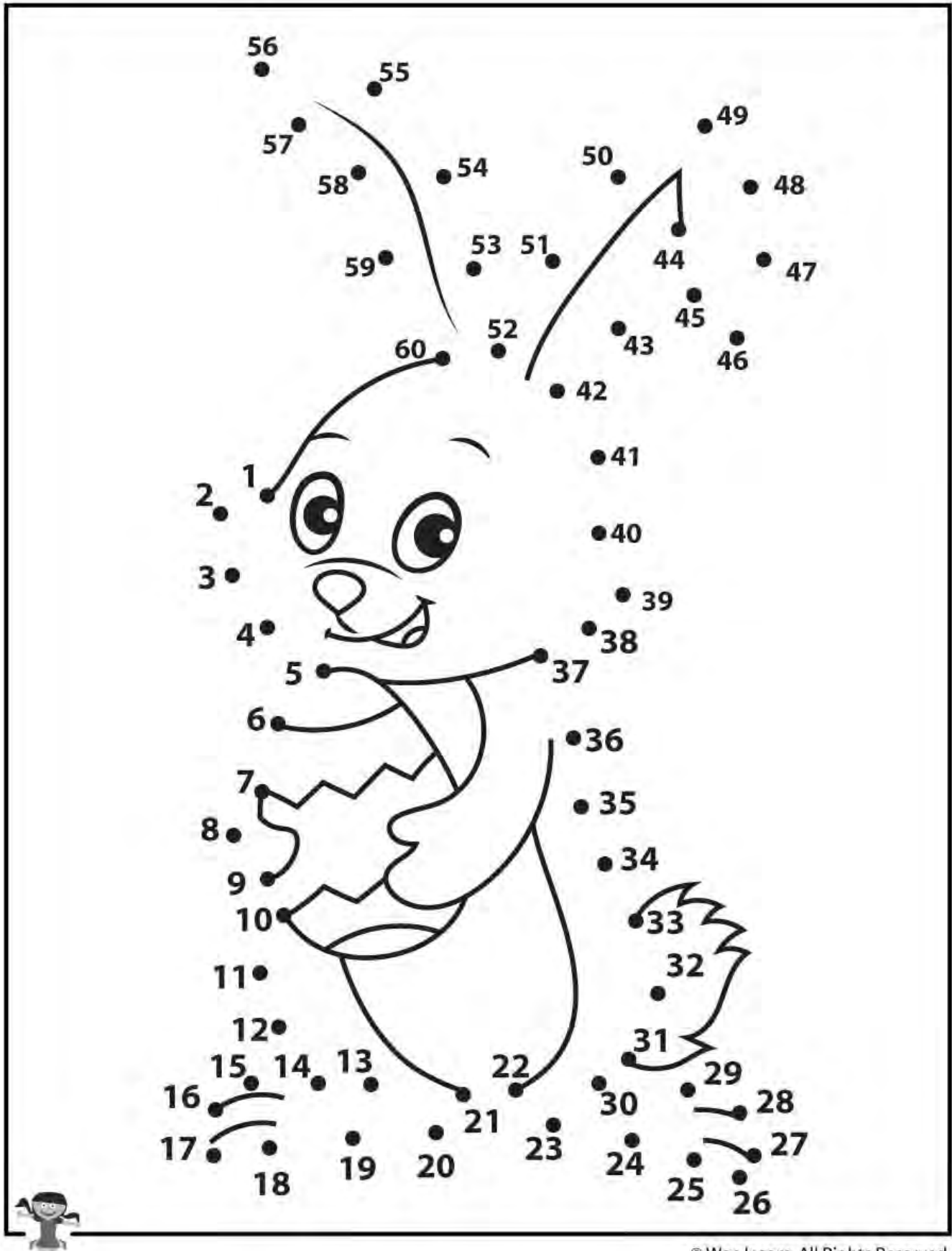

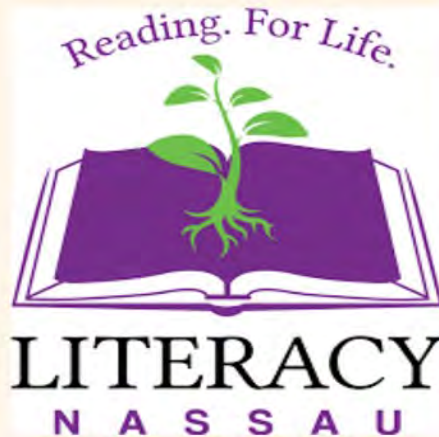


Living Lent as a Family (Part 4 of 4)
