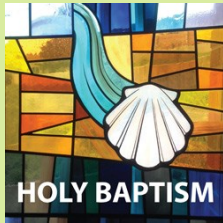

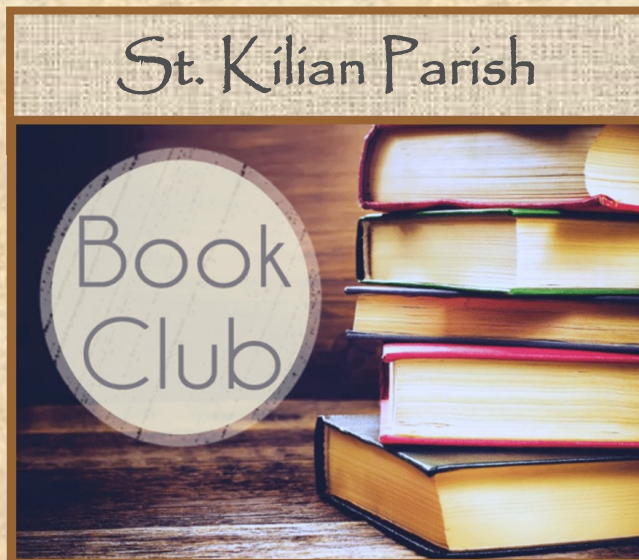

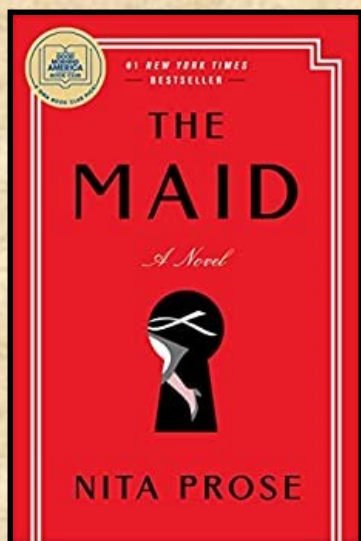
Did you Know...St. Kilian's has a Book Club?

April 2: Palm Sunday

Today is Palm Sunday and the beginning of the holiest of Christian weeks. Let us pray for the grace to take up our own cross and to follow Jesus through death to new life. April 9: Easter Sunday

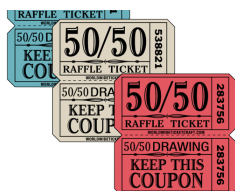

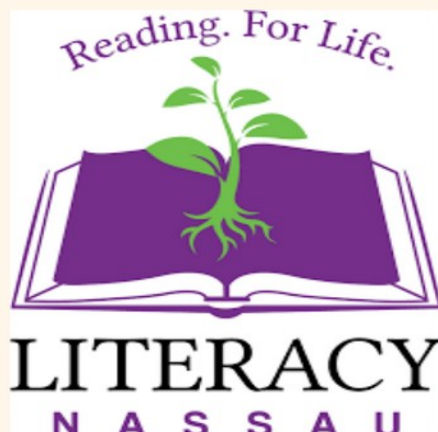
