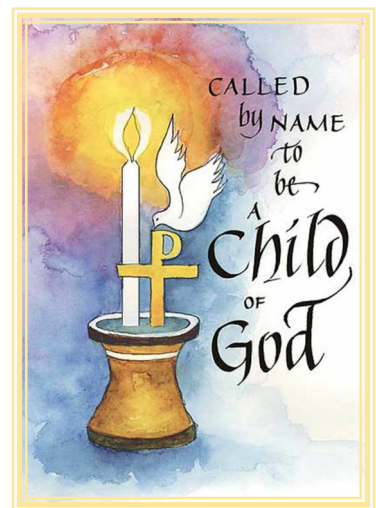

Matrimony:

Marriage arrangements should be made with a deacon or priest at least six months before the proposed wedding date. No dates for marriage will be given

over the phone. Note: The interview to schedule the marriage date at St. Kilian should be completed before commitments are made with acatering hall. Additional information is available on the parish website: www.stkilian.com.



Anointing of the Sick:

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick may be received by any Catholic who is preparing for surgery, or is of advanced age, or is seriously ill. The

sacrament is the Church's prayer for health and healing and should not be delayed until there is danger of death. Please call the rectory to speak with a priest. Also, to arrange for Communion to be brought to the homebound, please call the rectory to have a priest visit. After the priest visits, arrangements can be made for a Eucharistic Minister to regularly bring communion to the homebound.

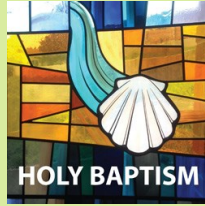

I'd like to have a Mass said for someone who recently passed away. How would I get one? Please call or stop by the rectory for a Mass Card. Mass Intentions are \$20 and the name of the deceased or living individual will be announced at Mass.

I was Baptized but never received my First Communion or Confirmation and am interested in finding out how to receive my other Sacraments. What do I do now? I'd like to spend some quiet time in the Church. Is it open during the day? Yes, the Church building is generally open from 9am to 5pm. We also have the beautiful, recently renovated St. Benedict Chapel located across the street in the rectory. On Wednesdays there is a 12:15pm Mass followed by Eucharistic Adoration in the chapel.

We would like to remind everyone for the safety of all participants, it is important to complete the Virtus Online Safe Environment requirements required by the Diocese of Rockville Centre.

Once your Virtus Online account is set up you should login to check that your account information and any updated information is completed in a timely manner. If they are not updated, the Diocese of Rockville Centre which is conducting its annual audit will deactivate your account access and you will be delayed in your volunteering efforts.

The Diocese of Rockville Centre Virtus Requirements include:

1. Attend a Virtus Online training class-"Protecting God's Children for Adults"
2. Complete full background check screening every 5 years
3. Sign Code of Conduct and required documents
4. Update training bulletins assigned to individual account every month

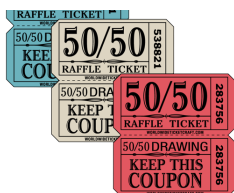

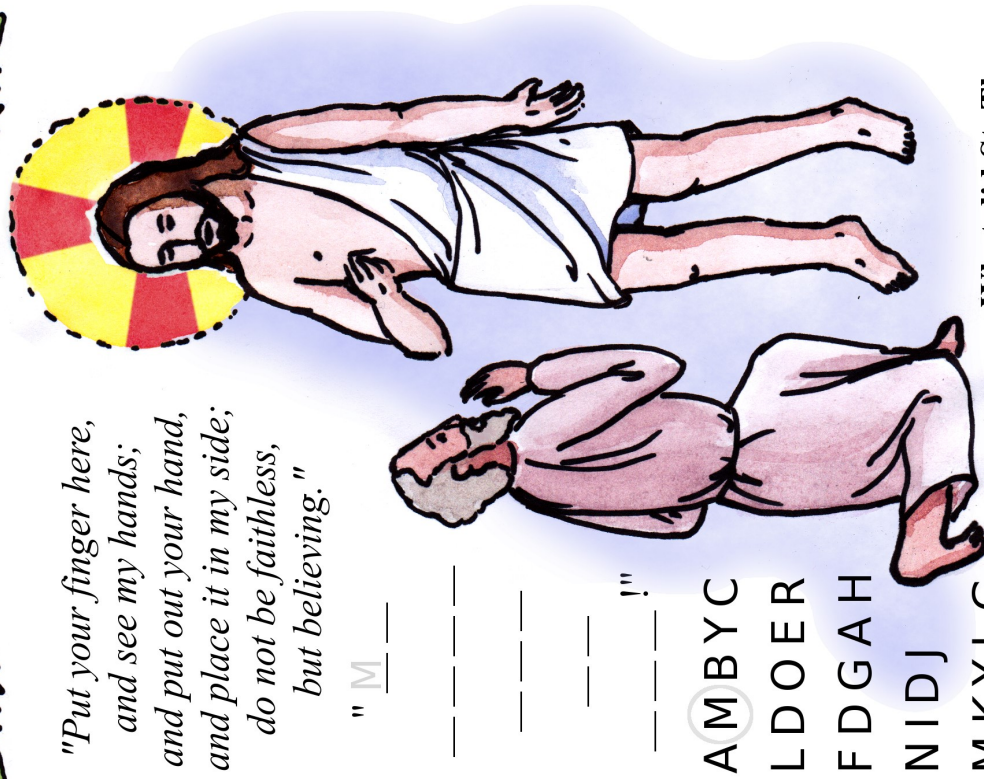
