Congratulations, Deacon George Owen, on your 25th Anniversary of Ordination as a Deacon!

George Beardsley Owen was born January 15th, 1930 in Brooklyn, New York. He was raised by his paternal grandparents and attended services at St. Paul's Episcopal Church. George (or "Buzzy" as he was known) enjoyed playing baseball and other games with friends in his Bergen Beach neighborhood.

In 1947, at the age of 17, young George left high school to join the United States Navy. He spent the next ten years as a radar man stationed on destroyer class ships including the USS Zellars out of Norfolk, Virginia. After his service, George earned an AS degree in Engineering from Brooklyn College.

George married Brooklyn native, Patricia Ann Math, on September 2nd, 1951. Their first child, Kathleen Marie, died during infancy after a bout of pneumonia. God blessed George and Pat with five more children: Kevin, Eileen, Dennis, Brian and Deirdre. George converted to Catholicism in order to effectively lead his children in faith. The family moved to Farmingdale in 1962 where life centered on St. Kilian Church, Drum and Bugle Corp., sporting events and camping. George was a scout master for Boy Scout Troop 57 and a member of the St. Kilian bowling league. He was passionate about many hobbies including gardening, running and growing show chrysanthemums. Over their 61 years in Farmingdale, George and Pat developed many deep and lasting friendships. With these friends they enjoyed fellowship and vacations; while sharing the joys and challenges of life.

Upon retiring from New York Telephone Company after a 30 year engineering career, George began volunteering more at St. Kilian. A fellow parishioner recommended him to the Diocese for the diaconate program. After much prayer and consideration, George accepted and, after 4 years of study, he was ordained on May 23, 1998. During his tenure, Deacon George served mass, and presided over many Baptisms, Communions, Confirmations, weddings and funerals. Additionally, he has worked closely with the Boy Scouts, Outreach, and the Women's Guild.

While reflecting on the 25th anniversary of his ordination, Deacon George said "Being a Deacon at St. Kilian Parish was one of the greatest honors of my life. I learned so much about the Catholic faith and enjoyed working with church staff and parishioners". At age 93, George's family has now expanded to include 10 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren. They are all extremely proud of George's service as a Deacon. He has been an excellent example for future generations of steadfast faith, commitment to country and dedication to family. George has inspired many with his enthusiastic willingness to serve God and his Farmingdale community.

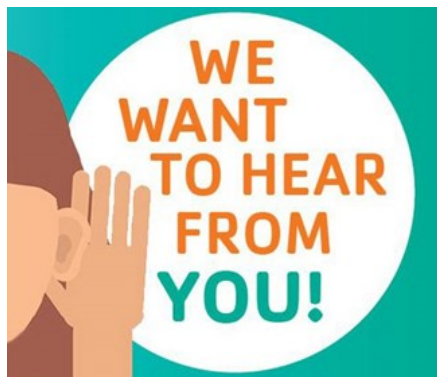

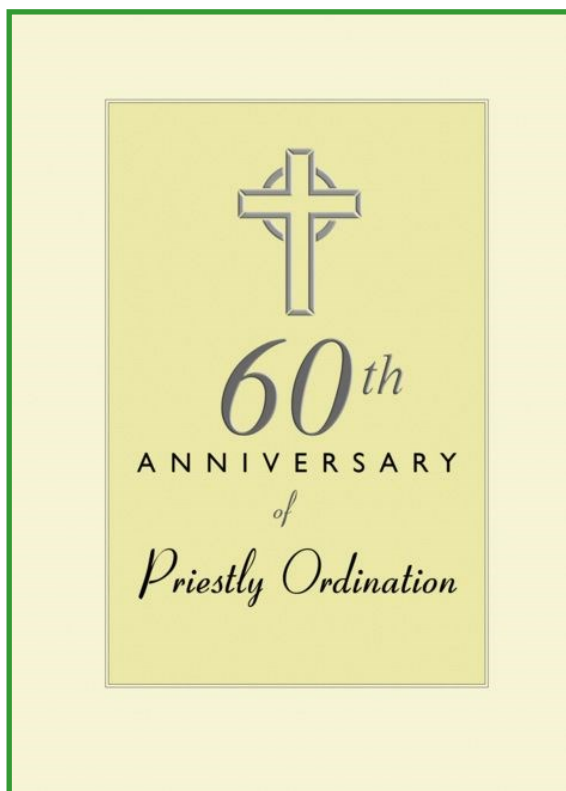

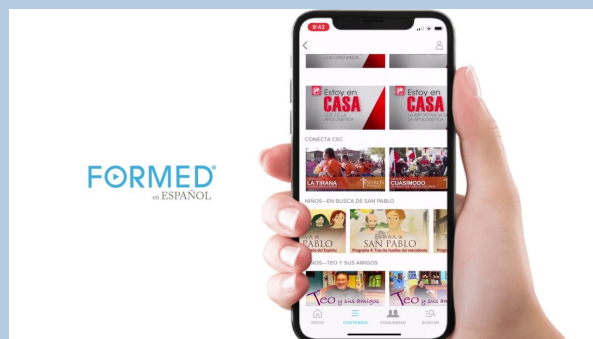
