

A Message from Msgr. Rowan about the Playground in the Schoolyard

Dear Parishioners,

We have recently had an inspection performed on the school yard playground and received a report saying that to bring it up to current safety standards, it would cost nearly \$70,000 to make it safe and compliant.

Over the twenty years since the last refurbishment, many components have deteriorated or broken, and the safety surfacing has been damaged or even worn down to the concrete in many places.




In the current economic climate, I do not believe such a large expense is manageable, and since we do not currently have an active school neither is it necessary. As such, we will be removing the playground from the school yard.



I regret taking down the playground, but we cannot afford the expense of \$70,000 and we must consider the safety of all who use the playground, as well as liability issues for lawsuits that the current condition of the playground presents.
