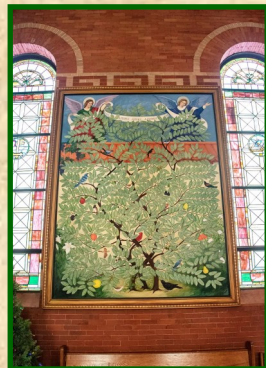

Baptism:

Reconciliation:

Reconciliations are heard in the Church on Saturdays 4:00 - 4:45pm and Mondays at 1pm during Advent and Lent. For confessions in English or Spanish please call the rectory at (516) 249-0127 to schedule an appointment.



Matrimony:

Marriage arrangements should be made with a deacon or priest at least six months before the proposed wedding date. No dates for marriage will be given over the phone. Note: The interview to schedule the marriage date at St. Kilian should be completed before commitments are made with acatering hall. Anointing of the Sick:

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick may be received by any Catholic who is preparing for surgery, or is of advanced age, or is seriously ill. The sacrament is the Church's prayer for health and healing and should not be delayed until there is danger of death. Please call the rectory to speak with a priest. Also, to arrange for Communion to be brought to the homebound, please call the rectory to have a priest visit. After the priest visits, arrangements can be made for a Eucharistic Minister to regularly bring communion to the homebound.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

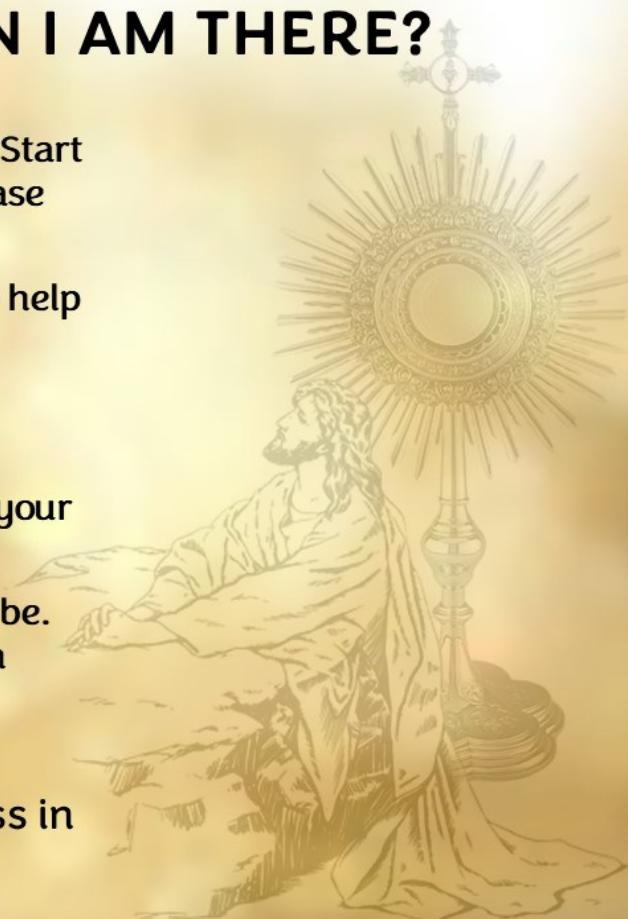
"Remain in me, as I remain in you."

Adoration is a devotional practice of adoring and praying in the real presence of our Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. It involves "the contemplation of the Mystery of Christ truly present before us". Jesus invites us to a personal relationship. Through this "friendship" we are inspired to take on life's challenges with a new perspective, knowing that He is always with us.

WHAT DO I DO WHEN I AM THERE?

1. Be patient. It takes time to be still and pray. Start with smaller time periods and slowly increase your time.
2. Bring scripture or other spiritual reading to help you meditate.
3. Silently pray the Rosary.
4. Listen to spiritual music (with your headphones!) to help you still yourself and turn your thoughts to God.
5. Be okay with silence. Allow yourself to just be. Stick to it – eventually you will be filled with insurmountable peace.

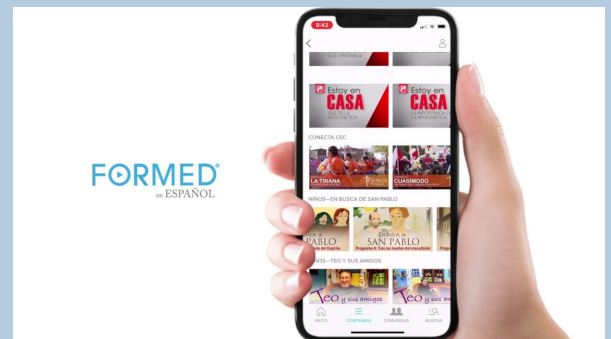


