



Outreach is our parish community's response to the Gospel call to help those in need. We serve anyone who lives within our parish boundaries regardless of religion, race or ethnicity. We are located at 140 Elizabeth Street but our main entrance is in the parking lot facing Conklin Street.

Our Fiscal Year ended on August 31<sup>st</sup> and we would like you to know that it was ONLY through your generosity that we were able to provide our Outreach services in answer to God's call.

In the 12 months between 9/1/22 and 8/31/23, we assisted an average of 536\* people each month AND provided 11,099\* services, including:

- ◆ food pantry and food stamp application assistance
- van transportation
- clothing referrals
- school supplies
- employment counseling
- ♦ holiday help
- friendly visiting

- birthday bags
- heating assistance/applications, shelter referrals
- case management
- information/referrals to government and other non-profit agencies
- ♦ advocacy
