St. Kilian's has two part-time positions available:

A part-time **Sacristan** to work 10-15 hours per week, primarily on weekends, with occasional hours weekday mornings and later in the day as needed. Flexibility in scheduling is important.

Responsibilities:

- Open and close the church for Masses and services
- Setting up for and assisting the Presider during daily Masses, funerals, and weddings
- Care of the sacred vessels.
- Assist in monitoring necessary supplies for the Church
- Assist with the upkeep & maintenance of all church areas
- Effectively manage time and complete all tasks as assigned by the Pastor

A part-time, weekend **Maintenance Worker**. This position is approximately 16 hours per week, with Saturday and Sunday shifts required. Flexible hours with some additional evening hours required for special events. Availability some weekday hours to fill in for weekday maintenance personnel absences is a plus.

Responsibilities:

- Ensure parish buildings are maintained in a clean and orderly manner.
- Perform janitorial duties including dusting, sweeping floors, mopping, and submitting a weekly log sheet for records purposes and compliance.
- Assist in opening and/or locking buildings and provide set-up and cleaning of facilities for all activities and events as needed.
- Able to maintain and/or repair various items on the property as needed.
- Inform management when orders for supplies and materials are needed.
- Complete incident reports if necessary and return them to the Business and facility Manager.
- Any other parish duties deemed necessary by the Pastor or his delegates.

Qualifications:

- Requires working knowledge of and skill in maintenance tasks.
- Attention to detail and ability to follow instructions.
- Able to communicate effectively with staff, parish volunteers, and parishioners.
- Must be capable of lifting 50+ pounds.
- Able to climb ladders.
- Carpentry experience is a plus.

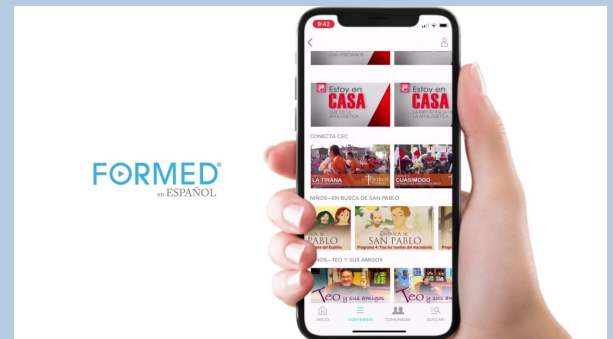
