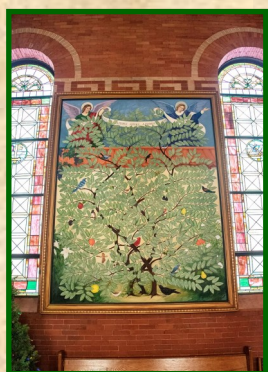

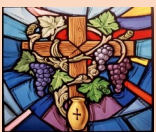

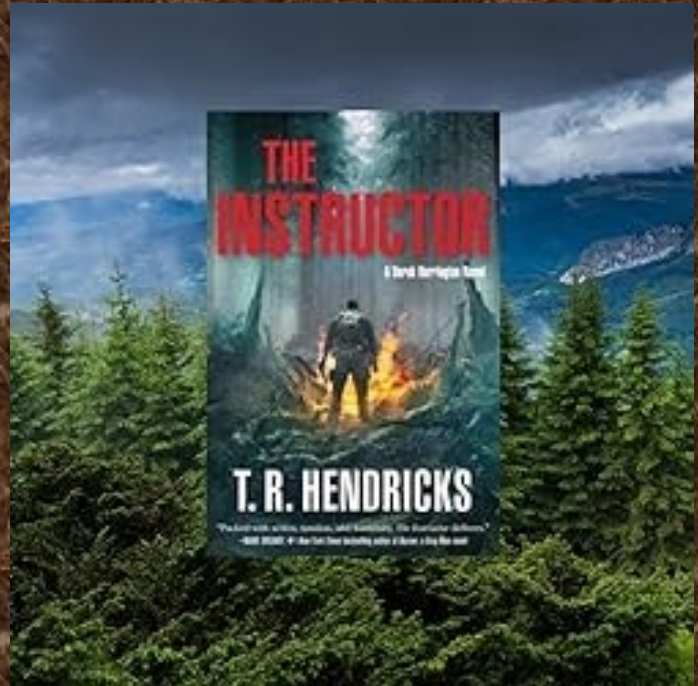

## Keep Christ in Christmas Poster Contest

There will be a first prize and second prize winner in each age group. First prize is a \$50 gift card and second prize is a \$25 gift card. Poster size must be 11x17 inches. Poster must be original work and reflect the theme of Keep Christ in Christmas and will be judged on child's authenticity and expression of the theme. If pastels, chalk or charcoal are used, the poster must be laminated or covered with clear plastic.

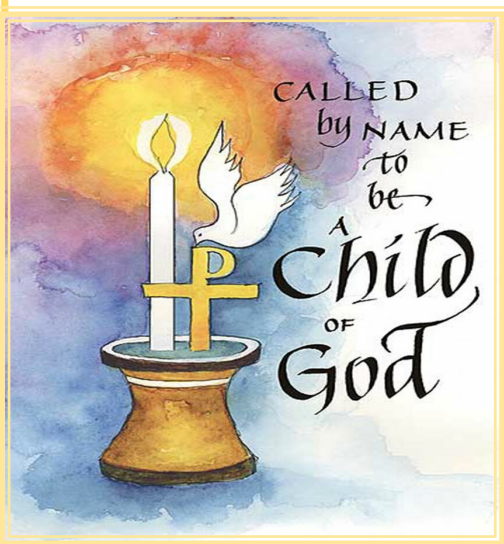

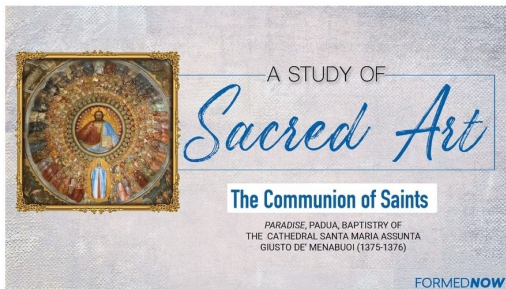

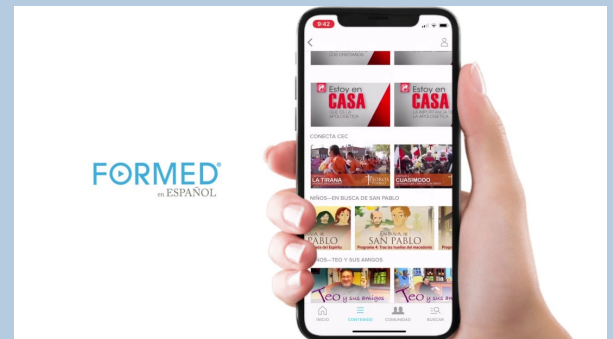
