#### Matrimony:

Marriage arrangements should be made with a deacon or priest at least six months before the proposed wedding date. No dates for marriage will be given

After the priest visits, arrangements can be made for a Eucharistic Minister to regularly bring communion to the homebound.

The season runs January through May and includes weekly practices at St Kilian gym, regulation games and play-offs. Any adults who would like to volunteer to coach will need to submit background check paperwork and take the parish mandated VIRTUS training as well as attending a coaches meeting from CYO.
