# Parish Financial Report

Dear St. Kilian's Parishioners: I would like to share with you a summary of our financial report for the past fiscal year: 9/1/2022-8/31/2023.

Allow me to highlight a few points:

Our operating income, supporting the day-to-day operation of the church, was 9.9% lower than budgeted and 5.02% lower than last year. Regular Mass collections were 11.74% lower than budget and 4.33% lower than the previous year. Our Christmas and Easter collections combined were down 31.74% from budget and 19.63% from last year.

Our operating expenses were 24.59% above budget and 35.60% above last year's. While we have instituted cost reductions in several areas, including personnel, repairs and maintenance projects that had either been deferred or were unexpected accounted for a large part of the issue. Despite the best planning, on a campus as large (with 4 buildings) and as old as ours, things break down, often unexpectedly. A heating pipe leak in the school (only partially covered by insurance), repairs to outdoor safety lighting around the campus, other plumbing, and HVAC issues, maintenance issues for the organ and other repairs add up quickly.

Gas, water, and electricity costs also saw increases totaling 24.5% over last year.

Additionally, the cost of postage continues to rise, by almost 5% in 2023, and will do so again next year.

We also saw an astounding increase in needs presented to our Parish Social Ministry and food pantry. Client aid needs increased by 130% over last year.

We are getting by at this moment. However, our facilities are aging, and routine repairs and maintenance are an ongoing concern. With our income seeing decreases, it will become more difficult to maintain everything. We are still moving forward on Capital Campaign projects, addressing some pressing building needs. These are accomplished with monies that are restricted to those projects specifically and raised through campaign pledges.

Energy costs that increased over the past year will likely do so again. As well, insurance costs have skyrocketed. These concerns will further strain our budgets. We have, of course, adjusted the current year's budget plans according to these factors and decreasing incomes (collections are already seeing a modest decline from last year).

We're continuing our "belt tightening" to trim costs wherever possible and are working to find a new tenant for the school building to create a new revenue stream from leasing that space.

As always, thank you for ongoing support of and generosity toward St. Kilian's parish.
