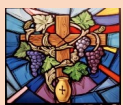

Matrimony:

Marriage arrangements should be made with a deacon or priest at least six months before the proposed wedding date. No dates for marriage will be given

Anointing of the Sick:

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick may be received by any Catholic who is preparing for surgery, or is of advanced age, or is seriously ill. The

Also, to arrange for Communion to be brought to the homebound, please call the rectory to have a priest visit. After the priest visits, arrangements can be made for a Eucharistic Minister to regularly bring communion to the homebound.

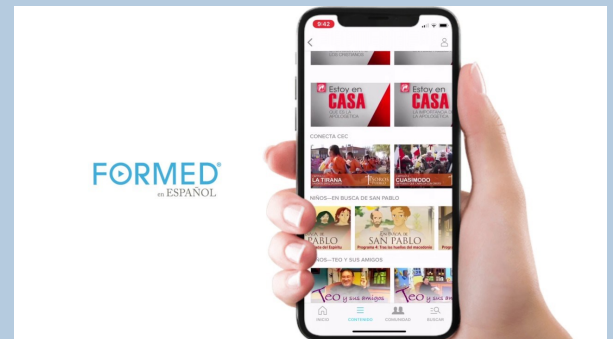
