

I've been away from the Church for a while but I was thinking of coming back and would like to make an appointment to speak to a priest or deacon. How would I do that? That's great news! You can call the rectory and leave a message for any one of St. Kilian's clergy. You can also check the front page of the parish bulletin for email addresses. Msgr. Rowan, our Pastor's email address is: pastor@stkilian.com.

I'd like to have a Mass said for someone who recently passed away. How would I get one? Please call or stop by the rectory for a Mass Card. Mass Intentions are \$20 and the name of the deceased or living individual will be announced at Mass.

I was Baptized but never received my First Communion or Confirmation and am interested in finding out how to receive my other Sacraments. What do I do now? Please call St. Kilian's Faith Formation at (516) 694 - 0633 for further information. We look forward to assisting you in completing your Sacraments!

I'd like to spend some quiet time in the Church. Is it open during the day?

Yes, the Church building is generally open from 9am to 5pm. We also have the beautiful, recently renovated St. Benedict Chapel located across the street in the rectory. On Wednesdays there is a 12:15pm Mass followed by Eucharistic Adoration in the chapel.

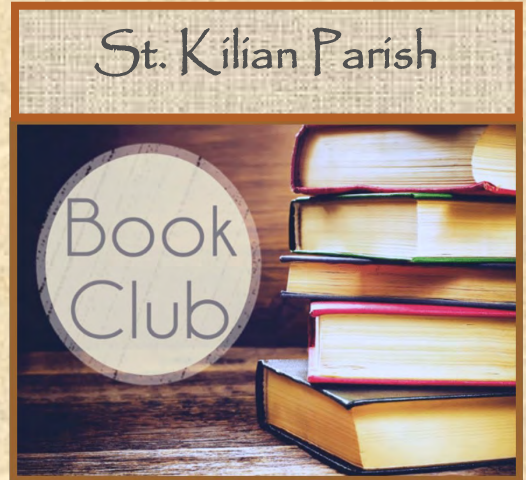
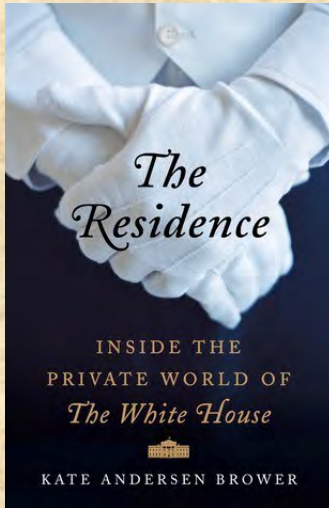

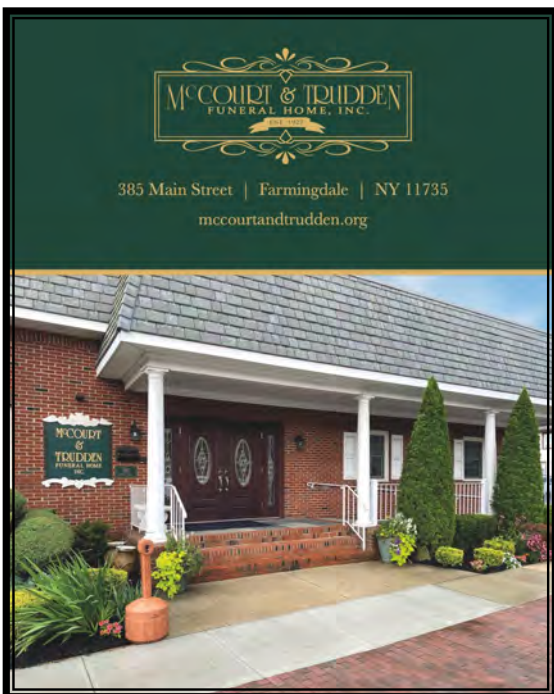
