



Preparing for our Parish Pilgrimage...

What is a Pilgrimage?

In a Jubilee Year, one of the hallmarks is that of Catholics participating in a pilgrimage. Catholic Pilgrims from all over the world are making their way to Rome for this year's Jubilee theme created by Pope Francis, "Pilgrims of Hope". But what is a "pilgrimage"? A pilgrimage is more than just taking a trip. It's a call for Catholics to set out on a faith journey and to cross boundaries!

When we travel, we not only change place physically, but we also change ourselves. Hence, we begin by preparing ourselves: we plan the route, learn about the destination and then grow in community with our fellow travelers on this pilgrimage of deepening our faith. In this sense, the Jubilee pilgrimage begins before the start of the journey itself. The starting point is the decision to set out. The etymology of the word "pilgrimage" is telling and has undergone little change in meaning over the years. The word comes from the Latin "*per ager*," meaning "across the fields," or perhaps from "*per eger*" meaning "border crossing": both possible origins point to the distinctive aspect of undertaking a journey.

Another feature of a taking a pilgrimage is that it allows Catholics to receive a "plenary indulgence". So what does that mean?

The idea of indulgences is frequently misunderstood, especially because of the history of the abuse of indulgences in the Middle Ages and at the time of the Protestant Reformation. An indulgence is *not* a permission to commit sin. It is *not* a permission to indulge in some behavior that would ordinarily be considered sinful. It is *not* something that you pay for to get forgiveness.

An indulgence is simply the action of the Church by which she opens the treasury of graces for us and bestows the grace of Christ and the saints upon us as a means of making atonement for our sins. In this way, the Church wipes away the temporal punishment that we deserve for committing sin. These indulgences are granted to Catholics whenever they say a specific prayer or do some other pious exercise specified by the Church for the obtaining of an indulgence. There is no decree granting an indulgence. There is no application made for an indulgence. The Church simply promises to Catholics that, if they pray certain prayers, she will open the treasury of graces for them!

Once received, the Faith Formation Office will contact you to confirm that the enrollment has been received and provide you with tuition and payment information.

Class assignments will be finalized in early September, and a schedule will be sent to you for your child/children at that time.

Why Do I Volunteer?

My husband Tom and I have lived in Farmingdale since April of 1977. We moved from Astoria Queens, I was a stay-at-home mother of 2 preschool children, he was a New York City Policeman. That September my daughter Christine began kindergarten at St. Kilian's school, and I joined the Mother's Club. It was there that I learned of the parish Respect Life Committee

from Rita Broyles (RIP) and became a Birthright volunteer, it was a cause close to my heart. Another member, Ann Schmitt (RIP) soon followed into Birthright, and she would become my best friend. Birthright was a Crisis Pregnancy Center where love and support were offered in the office and on the phone; baby clothes, pampers and other practical help was distributed without cost. Back in those days there were no home pregnancy tests, Birthright offered a free pregnancy test. A urine sample was driven to the nearby lab down Hempstead Turnpike. When we took that sample and gave the results, we had 2 opportunities to discuss alternatives to abortion in person with that mother, babies were saved. The home pregnancy test eliminated many opportunities for those conversations. About 20 years ago our landlord needed the space next to St. Kilian's and the Birthright office closed. We had 5 children then and 1 granddaughter. I didn't go to the Wantagh office, I became involved in parish ministries, I stayed to bloom where I was planted.

While I've never been an usher or in the choir, I have been involved in many ministries through the years, right now I'm a member of the Women's Guild and have served on its Board many times, I'm a Eucharistic Adorer on Wednesdays, a 1st grade catechist, and an OSS leader. I'm part of Family Ministry, running the Book Trolley on Hospitality Sunday which is the parish's Children's Library. Ministry to the children of Farmingdale is very important to me, our children need to know about their Catholic faith, the world needs people of faith... a book in some small way can nourish the seeds of that faith. I enjoy sharing a good book especially with a child, so this is a good fit for me. Over many of those years Tom worked 2 and more jobs while I remained a stay at Mom and then a grandmother of 9. I could never have been involved in so many ministries had I worked outside the home. I am very grateful to him. Now that he is finally fully retired, Tom's an Outreach volunteer and drives the van, something he really enjoys doing. He enjoys hearing the stories of the folks he's driving, he's always willing to switch with another driver or do an extra drive.
