

#### Baptism:

#### Reconciliation:

#### Matrimony:

Marriage arrangements should be made with a deacon or priest at least six months before the proposed wedding date. No dates for marriage will be given

#### Anointing of the Sick:

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick may be received by any Catholic who is preparing for surgery, or is of advanced age, or is seriously ill. The

sacrament is the Church's prayer for health and healing and should not be delayed until there is danger of death. Please call the rectory to speak with a priest. Also, to arrange for Communion to be brought to the homebound, please call the rectory to have a priest visit. After the priest visits, arrangements can be made for a Eucharistic Minister to regularly bring communion to the homebound.

Recently we have had to twice have the church elevator serviced due to door issues. These result from people holding the doors for too long. Please do not hold the doors so we may avoid additional cost for this servicing.



Over the past several months, we have had issues in the handicapped lot adjacent to the church with improperly parked vehicles.

This includes both vehicles parked in handicapped only spaces without the required permit and vehicles parked in the fire lane (the rest of the paved area). This creates an impediment to the arrival of any emergency services that are needed in the church. We attempted to inform the vehicle owners of the need for them to follow these appropriate parking rules in this lot to little success.

We are therefore, unfortunately, forced to take a more drastic step and have the Village's Code Enforcement Officers issue tickets to vehicles parked improperly in this lot. We're sorry that this is necessary, but safety must be our priority.
