Special characters (hearts, cross, shamrock, star) are counted as 3 spaces each. All text is capitalized and centered based on the number of lines and text included. All text is subject to approval. **Please, one brick per intention/memory.**






Ministry of Consolation Companions are caring and empathetic members of our Parish community who journey with bereaved families at a very difficult time. Training for this ministry will be provided.


