

Each letter (A-Z), punctuation (dash, comma, etc.) number (0-9) and space between these is counted as 1 space on the brick. Special characters (hearts, cross, shamrock, star) are counted as 3 spaces each. All text is capitalized and centered based on the number of lines and text included. 
Help Us Reach Local Seniors in Need of Transportation!






Ministry of Consolation Companions are caring and empathetic members of our Parish community who journey with bereaved families at a very difficult time. Training for this ministry will be provided.


