Year of Hope closes on The Feast of the Epiphany

The Catholic Church's 2025 Jubilee Year of Hope, themed "Pilgrims of Hope" and started by Pope Francis on Christmas Eve 2024, officially closes with the sealing of the Holy Doors in Rome on January 6, 2026. Pope Leo XIV will close the door at St. Peter's Basilica, which is also The Feast of the Epiphany.

The Feast of the Epiphany is a custom in many nationalities and a Christian tradition where families bless their home at the start of the New Year by writing the inscription 20 + C + M + B + 26 (for the current year) above the front door with blessed chalk, inviting Christ to dwell in their home for the year. The letters C, M, B stand for the traditional names of the Three Wise Men (Caspar, Melchior, Balthazar) and also for the Latin phrase Christus Mansionem Benedicat, meaning "May Christ bless this house". The blessing involves prayers, holy water, and marking the doorframe as a symbol of inviting Jesus into the home.

Here at St. Kilian we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany at Masses on the weekend of January 4th and invite you to take home a House Blessing Kit after Mass. Kits will be at the Church entrances and will include easy instructions. One kit per family please.




Anointing of the Sick:
