Memorial Brick Order Form

All orders received after February 23, 2026, will be included in bricks that will be inscribed on a quarterly basis after the initial installation in the spring.

We invite you to personalize a brick around the new Madonna & Child Garden, located on the east side of the church grounds. These Memorial Bricks will serve as a memorial or tribute to an individual, family, or special event such as a wedding or birth. As the bricks will be engraved in place on site, the exact location and placement of bricks cannot be guaranteed.



Two brick sizes are available: 4"x8" with three lines of text holding 14 spaces per line and 6"x9" with 4 lines of text holding 14 spaces per line.
