The collection for September 4th was \$8,824 with \$5,109 from the collection basket and \$3,715 from Faith Direct.

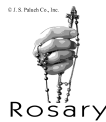

***Hidden in Plain Sight: Understanding Adolescent
Substance Use and Abuse***

Don Bosco Prep will host an exhibit and panel discussion led by the Bergen County Prevention Coalition on Thur. September 22 at 7:00 pm. This educational event to prevent youth drug use is suitable for parents, educators, other adult community members and any adult who works or cares about young people.
