A Message from the Pastor

*Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord
April 16, 2017*

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Alleluia! Alleluia! Those words ring out again! *To parishioners and visitors alike we offer a warm welcome and prayers for a faith-filled Easter Season!* What joy and hope we Christians have to celebrate the great feast of Easter: Jesus Christ is the true victor, the Risen Savior! His suffering, death and resurrection are reminders to us that even in our own lives, suffering and death do *not* have the last word ... for we have been baptized into the death AND resurrection of Jesus Christ!



What has your Lenten pilgrimage been like? Sunday Mass remains the heart of our faith – our obedience to the Lord's command: "do this in remembrance of me" sustains us in Word and Sacrament and strengthens us in the bonds of community and Christian charity.

We gathered for activities such as the Parish Breakfast, weekly ecumenical soup suppers, and the Be My Witness faith-sharing weekly gatherings. We sacrificed and shared through participating in operation Rice Bowl to benefit the works of Catholic Relief Services. We offered prayers and support for Maryknoll missionaries, Family Promise homeless shelters and Several Sources Shelters form pregnant teens. We were offered many opportunities to receive God's grace and mercy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and to meditate upon Our Lord's Passion during weekly Stations of the Cross. Thank you to all who make the experience of Guardian Angel parish vibrant and alive now and all year long!

As the Easter Season begins I think especially of the children who will be receiving Eucharist for the first time here at weekend Masses in the coming weeks. I hope we will look forward to participating at these Masses with them. And let us help them remember that they have been preparing not simply for "First Communion," but rather for *every Sunday with their families* at Mass. Entering the Easter Season also calls us to pray especially for our teenagers who will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation here on May 21st at 2 p.m. May they receive and share the gifts of the Holy Spirit abundantly and with enthusiasm! May the Spirit stir their hearts to deeper participation in the sacramental life of the Church!

Our presence here together to celebrate Eucharist on Easter also calls to mind God's invitation to us to this great banquet every Sunday. Do we take our faith for granted? In dangerous areas around the world, *Christians risk their very lives* for living the faith and for gathering for Sunday Mass. Please pray for them, and for the grace to be faithful in our own lives as well – now more than ever we are counter-cultural symbols, the light of Christ to those drowning in sin or anxiety, or into those numbed and seduced by entertainment and sports to the point of missing out on the weekly gift and call of Christ at Eucharist.
