A Message from the Pastor

October 27, 2019
Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear parishioners,

This weekend I will celebrate a “Mass of Farewell” at 11:30 a.m. on Sunday. All are welcome. At this point, I do know now that my official last day in the parish will be November 30th, so the new priest will begin the new liturgical year and the Season of Advent with you that weekend. I will be here for some Masses during the month of November. My actual last Mass with you will be the Mass for Thanksgiving Day, Thursday November 28th.

The following thoughts are adapted from a column I was asked to write for a recent article of The Catholic Advocate (newspaper of the Newark Archdiocese).

*

“My vocation, at last I have found it ... my vocation is love!”

- Story of a Soul: The Autobiography of St. Therese of Lisieux

These words written by St. Therese could indeed be a guiding thought for all Christians, for as Scripture teaches “God is love” (1 John 4:8). For the man called by God to the priesthood, these words of St. Therese are also especially meaningful, as the priest seeks to illuminate the love of God in all he says and does.

My Mass of Farewell is an opportunity to give thanks to God for the gift of the ministry of ordained priesthood in the life and mission of the Church. In doing so, we may also call to mind those priests we have known in our own lives – those who have guided, encouraged and challenged us in a life of faith through their vocation of love.

I have served as a priest for 27 years and have had the deep joy of serving the people of God primarily in parish life, first as a parochial vicar in Annunciation Church (Paramus) and Church of the Little Flower (Berkeley Heights) and then as pastor at Guardian Angel Church (Allendale). Each assignment brought me new experiences – such a variety of ways to witness to the love of God, and to witness it in the lives of parishioners and through various activities throughout the Newark Archdiocese. I have been aided by the generous spirit of so many, and am grateful to all those who collaborate with priests, and offer them prayers and encouragement. It is so hard to put into words what you all have meant to me here at Church of the Guardian Angel, and how I have grown because of your impact on my faith and how I perceive myself and the life of a priest.

Now our Archbishop, Cardinal Joseph Tobin, has asked me to take on a new full-time role, which I began October 1st: Vicar for Clergy and Director of Clergy Personnel. While it is difficult to leave here and daily

NEW SAINT IMAGES IN OUR PARISH CHURCH

As part of the renovation of our church in 2014, space was left open for a saints niche, with a temporary image of saints Pope John XXIII and Pope John Paul II (along with Pope Francis). We are pleased to announce that on Friday November 1st on the Solemnity of All Saints Day, Fr. Charlie will bless icon representations of St. Thomas More and St. Elizabeth Seton, at the 8pm Mass.

St. Thomas More born on February 7, 1478 is the patron saint of lawyers, civil servants, politicians, and difficult marriages. He is widely remembered as a man of tremendous integrity. He was a literary scholar, eminent lawyer, gentleman, father of four children, and chancellor of England. He was martyred for his faith under the reign of King Henry VIII. He died on July 6, 1535. His feast day is June 22.

Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton born on August 28, 1774 was the first American to be canonized as a saint. She married William Seton at age 19 and they had 5 children together before he passed at age 30. She founded the first American religious community for women, the Sisters of Charity. She opened the first American parish school and established the first American Catholic orphanage. She died on January 4, 1821. Her feast day is January 4th.

Prayer cards for each saint will be available in the coming weeks. Our hope is that these images will draw us to seek the intercession of these saints, and be an aesthetic addition to our parish church.

parish life, I see this as an opportunity to be of service to all the priests and deacons – and therefore to all the parishes and chaplaincies of our archdiocese.

During my time of transition, I have been especially mindful of words from the Rite of Ordination of Priests which have had a lasting impact on me: “Meditating on the law of the Lord, see that you believe what you read, that you teach what you believe, and that you practice what you teach.” I hope that has defined my life among you.

St. Therese also wrote that she was committed to praying for priests, “whose mission at times is as difficult to carry out as that of apostles preaching to the infidels.” Let us always pray for one another!
