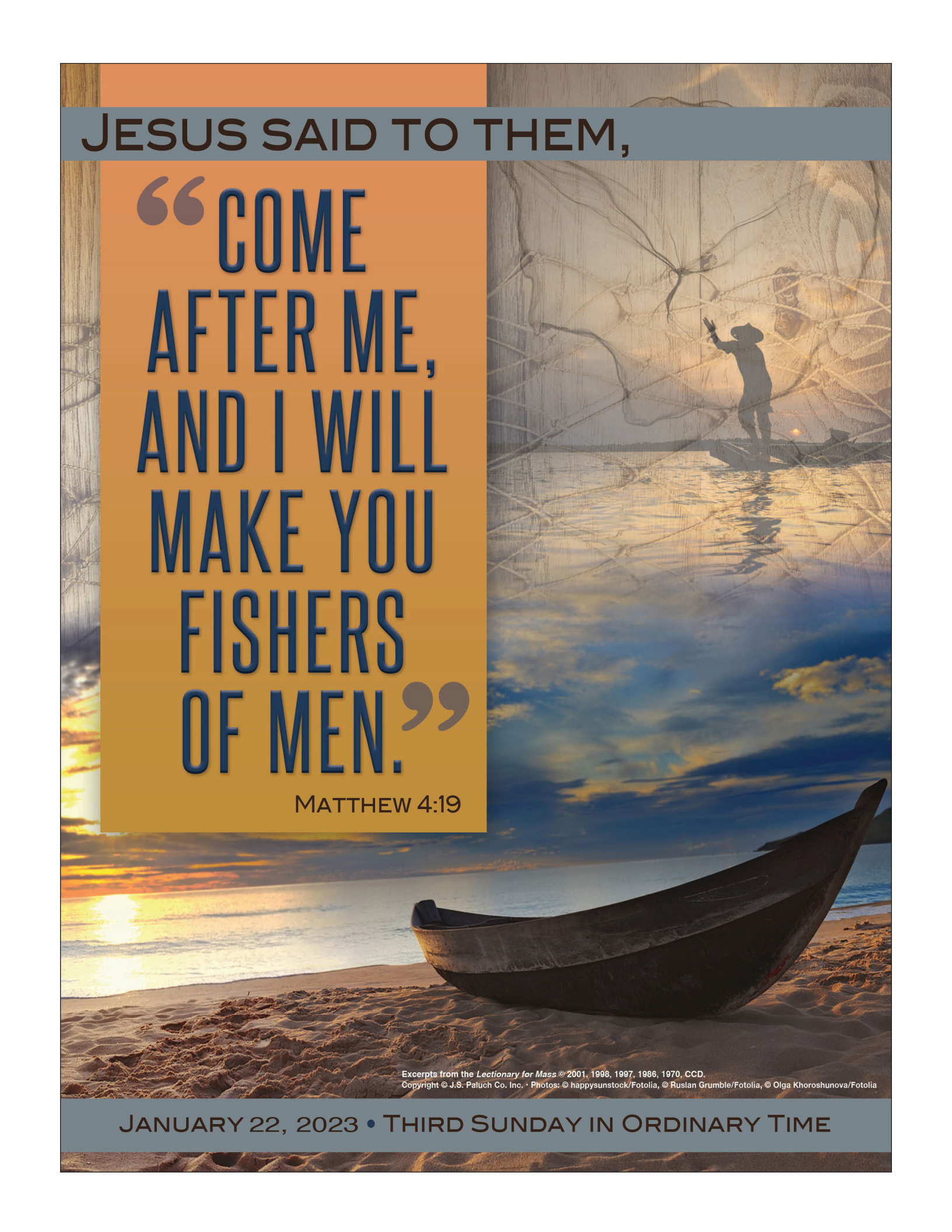

### Weekly Collection

### ANNUAL APPEAL 2023

The 2023 Annual Appeal Campaign, which benefits programs and ministries in the Archdiocese, begins next weekend.! Our **base goal is \$36,743** and our **stretch goal is \$47,196**.

The base goal is the amount to be guaranteed by our parish. If we do not meet our goal by December 31, 2023 the shortfall will be owed to the Archdiocese.

**Pledges made and paid by June 30, 2023 that exceed the stretch goal will be rebated to the parish and will reduce our assessment by up to 2%.**

New pledges and gifts made by parishioners July 1 - December 31, 2023 will directly be applied to the Appeal and will not be eligible for rebate to the parish.

Some of you have receive letters from Cardinal Tobin for the 2023 Appeal and an opportunity to make a pledge or gift! Pledge envelopes for all parishioners are coming next month. Continue to watch the bulletin and website for updated details.

## Fall deeper in love with Christ in the New Year

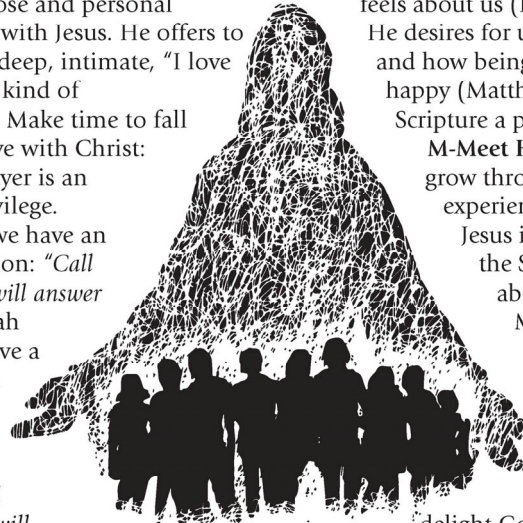
At the center of all we do as Catholics must be a close and personal relationship with Jesus. He offers to each of us a deep, intimate, "I love you forever" kind of relationship. Make time to fall deeper in love with Christ:

**T-Talk:** Prayer is an amazing privilege. Through it, we have an open invitation: "*Call to me, and I will answer you*" (Jeremiah 33:3). We have a promise that He hears us: "*When you call me, and come and pray to me, I will listen to you*" (Jeremiah 29:12). The God of the universe wants to hear from you.

**I-Intimacy:** To love Christ, we must know Him. In Scripture, God tells us

who He is (Exodus 34:6), how He feels about us (Isaiah 43:4), what He desires for us (Luke 12:32), and how being His will make us happy (Matthew 5-7). Make Scripture a part of every day.  
**M-Meet Him:** Relationships grow through shared experiences. We meet Jesus in prayer, Scripture, the Sacraments, and above all, during the Mass.

**E-Everything for love:** St. Thérèse of Lisieux discovered that she could delight God by simply picking up a pin out of love. He wants to hear us, His beloveds, say, "I love you, too," in words and actions. Essential to falling in love with God is making time for Him.

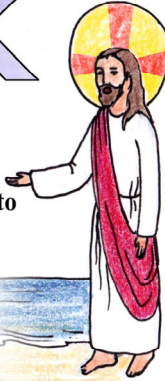

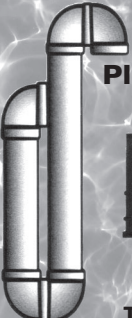
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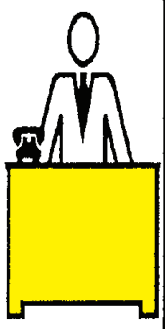


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
