This Mass is led today by the Fourth Grade Class of Nativity BVM Elementary School and by the combined forces our Cathedral Choir and Elementary School's Children's Choir.

THE SEVEN LAST WORD OF CHRIST: On Sunday, March 26th at 3:00 p.m. – we will offer a very powerful concert program that will take us through the crucifixion of Jesus and the seven "utterances" – statements he makes from the cross. Do you know them? In the musical setting – the "Fourth Word" of Jesus is: "God, my Father, why hast Thou forsaken me?" This pain filled statement is portrayed in the music as a baritone solo sung by our very own Dennis Burke. The "Fifth Word" of Jesus is "I am athirst!" The anguish of Jesus is presented with the backdrop of the angry crowd taunting and hurling insults at Jesus as He is dying on the cross. These two words/settings of music are portrayed with chorus and duets & trios between soloists. All the while we are favored to have a small Chamber Orchestral Ensemble to accompany the presentation.
