WHAT IS THE TRUE MEANING OF THE WORD "REQUIEM"?: Requiem is a Mass for the dead from Middle English. It comes from the Latin foundation meaning "Rest". It is taken from the first word of the phrase: "Requiem aeternum dona eis" translated as "Eternal rest grant to them." This is said or sung at the beginning of this version of the Mass. In our annual "All Souls" Concert - we share John Rutter's musical composition of the "Requiem" which sets parts of the "Requiem" Mass to music. In Rutter work's - he steps out of the confines of the traditional setting of just the parts of the Mass found in the liturgy and includes two Psalm settings - Psalm #130 & #23. On Sunday, October 29th at 4:00 pm we will offer this concert of Rutter's "Requiem" as a token of remembrance of all the souls we have lost this year and of those we wish to remember who have gone before us - in faith and love for their God.
