"ATTITUDE"

Today is the Thirteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time. In our first reading from Kings we find Elijah transferring his work of prophecy to Elisha, whom God has chosen. Elisha accepts God's call; "then he left everything and followed Elijah." Elisha has wholeheartedly left his life of comfort to follow the Lord. He slaughters and cooks his oxen, giving it to his people to eat. He has no intention of ever returning to his former life. He is committed. Jesus tells you in today's Gospel; "no one who sets his hand to the plow and looks to what was left behind is fit for the Kingdom." Christ calls you to participate in preaching His message of Salvation. Are you content in living the GOOD LIFE or can you leave it behind for Christ's call? Three people in the Gospel heard the call; they were willing to follow until the great – "BUT I" showed up. What is your – "BUT I"? Saint Paul addresses those things that hold you back saying; "live by the Spirit and you will certainly not gratify the desires of the flesh." How successful are you in resisting and rejecting the attractions of the world in order to follow Christ? How often have you told the Lord; "BUT I"? THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: 1 Kings 19:16b, 19-21

Elijah the prophet followed God's instruction to appoint a man named Elisha as his successor. Elijah threw his cloak over Elisha, who went and said good-bye to his family, then followed Elijah without question.

Second Reading: Galatians 5:1, 13-18

Paul reminds us that people were freed from the old law through Christ. But he makes it clear that this freedom does not mean giving in to evil desires. Instead, we must be guided by the Spirit and most importantly love our neighbor as ourselves.

Gospel: Luke 9:51-62

Jesus set out for Jerusalem, and passed through a town where he was not welcomed. He reprimanded his disciples for desiring vengeance against the town. One man wanted to follow Jesus when he had finished his duties at home. Jesus expressed that a man who begins a task, but constantly looks back is unfit for the reign of God.

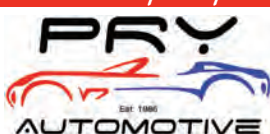
