"THE BOTTOM LINE!"

Today we Commemorate All the Faithfully Departed known as All Souls Day. Our readings focus on Suffering and Resurrection. The first reading from the Book of Wisdom speaks of our suffering when losing a loved one but then reminds us; "God tried them and found them worthy of Himself, and they shall abide with Him in Love." God did not promise us a rose garden in this life but in the next. Saint Paul in our second reading continues saying; "We are joint Heirs with Christ if only we suffer with Him so that we may be also Glorified with Him. Our suffering of this present time is nothing compared to the glory that awaits us." Everything Jesus said and did was in anticipation of His Resurrection. If you believe that Jesus was a great teacher, an admired spiritual leader and a charismatic personality, but do not believe in the Resurrection then you have fallen short. In our Gospel today Jesus raises the dead son of a widowed woman. We read that those who saw this miracle were seized with fear. What a great witness to the power of Jesus as our Lord and Savior. Their fear comes from their understanding of life and death being totally turned upside down. Who is He that conquers death??? They glorified God and this report spread throughout the region. **THE BOTTOM LINE IS THAT EVERYTHING FLOWS FROM OUR BELIEF IN THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST. THIS IS OUR HOPE, THIS IS OUR FAITH, THIS IS THE GOOD NEWS, THIS IS OUR CHURCH..... THIS IS HIS PROMISE!!!!**
