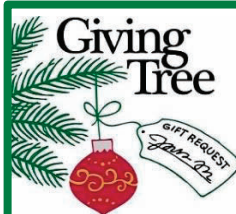

"HAVE YOU FALLEN IN LOVE?"

Today is the Feast of the Lateran Basilica which celebrates the Leadership and Unity of the Church under the Pope. In our first reading we hear the Prophet Ezekiel exclaim; "I saw water flowing out from beneath the threshold of the Temple." Ezekiel foresaw the Heavenly Temple revealed and bringing life giving waters, healing, and God's Divine Life being made present to the world. This was a foreshadowing of Jesus Christ, the Church and the Sacraments. In today's Gospel we read of Jesus cleaning out the temple profiteers saying, "stop making my Father's House a marketplace, for I will destroy this Temple and in 3 days raise it up!" The Apostles did not understand that Jesus had been referring to His own body until after His Resurrection. Saint Paul teaches; "You are God's building; you are the Temple of God and God's Spirit dwells in you!" He goes on to remind you that Christ is the Foundation. He is the Living Water coming down from Heaven, the water from Ezekiel's prophecy. It was from the side of Christ that blood and water flowed out bringing about the Eucharistic Sacrament. It is the Eucharist which feeds you with Divine Grace, growing the Church in Holiness. **HAVE YOU FALLEN IN LOVE WITH CHRIST, YOUR FAITH AND THE LIFE-GIVING GIFT OF THE SACRAMENTS? IF NOT, WHY NOT? CHRIST OPENED HIS ARMS ON THE CROSS, SAYING "THIS IS HOW MUCH I LOVE YOU," THEN HE BREATHED HIS LAST..... FOR YOU!!!**

Scripture Fulfilled

First Reading: Ezekiel 47:1-2, 8-9, 12

This reading from the Prophet Ezekiel tells of the streaming, healing waters that flow from the temple. These waters restore life to the river's inhabitants as well as the fruit bearing trees along its banks. It is believed that the water signifies blessings, whereas the lack of signifies trouble, hardship.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 3:9c-11, 16-17

Paul compares us to a building whose foundation has been laid by Jesus. As the people of God, we can only be solid if we are grounded in Christ.

Gospel: John 2:13-22

Near the time of Passover, Jesus went up to Jerusalem and saw the temple had become a marketplace. He became angry and proceeded to drive out the vendors and livestock. Jesus spoke of destroying the temple and rebuilding it in three days. The Jews did not know Jesus was speaking of his body, but when his resurrection from the dead came to pass, his disciples remembered what Jesus had said and came to believe the Scripture and the word Jesus had spoken.
