"THE REAL DEAL"

Today's readings speak about the LORD'S JUSTICE. Have you ever given any thought to what that might look like for you? The prophecy of Malachi, in our first reading and in today's Gospel, speaks about the inevitable coming of the Lord's Divine Justice. Will these prophecies be fulfilled in our own lifetime? There are many people today who feel we are fast approaching the end times, with famines, wars, earthquakes, Christian persecutions and powerful natural disasters. There are those who are storing up survival equipment, food, water, etc. What can you do to prepare? Do Not Be Afraid - Jesus gives you the answer when He says; "not a hair on your head will be destroyed, but by your perseverance you will secure your life." What does Jesus mean by "your perseverance"? Let's look at what Jesus DID NOT DO. He did not lie, cheat, curse, steal, gossip, envy, hate, abuse, malign or condemn. Instead, Jesus forgave, showed mercy, ate with sinners, and loved the unlovable. Will you forgive and show mercy, even when you find it difficult to do so, "persevering to the end?" St. Paul, in our second reading, encourages you to imitate Christ. Eternal Life comes at a cost, which is why Christ calls you to become "LOVE", in order to "LIVE". **LOVE IS THE MOST POWERFUL FORCE IN THE UNIVERSE. BE NOT AFRAID OF HIS DIVINE JUSTICE, BECAUSE IT IS BALANCED BY YOUR PRACTICE OF UNCONDITIONAL LOVE. IMITATE CHRIST AND YOU WILL BECOME THE REAL DEAL!!**

THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Malachi 3:19-20a

The prophet Malachi warned that the time would come when all the evil people would be punished. He then speaks of the arrival of "the sun of justice, with its healing rays," believed by most to mean Jesus.

Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 3:7-12

Some of the Thessalonians claimed Christ's return was imminent, so they stopped working and asked others for food. Paul describes his willingness to work, so that he would not impose on others. He encourages them to follow his example and earn their own living.

Gospel: Luke 21:5-19

Jesus warns of the persecution all Christians will face because of him, and how some will even be put to death. Yet he says they will not be harmed because "by patient endurance you will save your lives." If Jesus' followers are loyal, they will be resurrected, and their suffering will end.
