

"SALT AND LIGHT"

Today is the Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time. In our first reading the Prophet Isaiah says, "if you bestow bread on the hungry and satisfy the afflicted, then your light shall break forth like the dawn and when you cry for help the Lord will answer you saying, Here I AM!" We often hear people say they are spiritual but not religious, meaning they believe in God or follow Jesus, but not the Church. In today's Gospel Jesus gives a teaching on what it means to be His disciple, to be Salt and Light, saying, "you must be the Salt of the earth and so your Light must shine out before others glorifying your Heavenly Father." What good is salt unless it preserves or increases the flavor of what we digest? What good is your light if it is hidden? What good is your faith, belief or being spiritual if it does not serve others by preaching, proclaiming and giving public Glory to the Lord? Are you truly a disciple of Christ by separating yourself from His church where you are fed and nourished? Is being "spiritual" just a comfortable place that calls for no commitment and no demands. Jesus demands commitment from those He calls His own. When we pray, sing, and praise Jesus in community we are answering His call to be both Salt and Light! **SAINT PAUL PREACHES, "MY MESSAGE AND MY PROCLAMATION WERE NOT DONE WITH PERSUASIVE WORDS OF WISDOM, BUT A DEMONSTRATION OF FAITH, SPIRIT AND THE POWER OF CHRIST CRUCIFIED." FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Isaiah 58:7-10

This reading is a vigorous exhortation from the prophet Isaiah to lead lives of active charity and generosity. He promises that the Lord will be our "dawn," our "rear guard," our "light" if we share our bread, shelter the homeless, and clothe the naked.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 2:1-5

Paul tells the Corinthians that he and they must not rely on the so-called "wisdom" of secular teaching and philosophy but on the power of the Spirit.

Gospel: Matthew 5:13-16

Jesus reminds the disciples and all Christians that they carry special responsibilities to be "the salt of the earth." They must not hide their light but show their goodness to all.
