"DO NOT BE AFRAID"

Today is the Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time and our first reading is from the Book of Kings. We find the Prophet Elijah discovering the voice of the Lord, not in the strong wind, the fire or the powerful earthquake, but in a tiny whispering sound. Elijah recognizes God's presence as he attentively watched God move in his life. Are you listening for that whisper that calls you closer to the Lord? In our second reading Saint Paul laments over those people who have not believed in Jesus as the Messiah, saying, "I have great sorrow and constant anguish in my heart, my conscience joins with the Holy Spirit that Christ is God." Maybe, like Saint Paul, you have been praying for the conversion of a loved one without any success. Keep praying because in today's gospel we find the remedy. Jesus is seen by the Apostles walking on water towards their boat during a storm. Peter wishes to join Jesus, steps out of the boat takes a few steps, gets frightened then begins to sink. What storm is drowning you in your life? Have courage my friend because Jesus tells you in today's Gospel, "O thee of little faith, why do you doubt, take courage for it is I, Jesus. Do not be afraid." Jesus called Peter out of the boat, just as He calls you and I to come to Him filled with trust and faith. When you pray, know your prayer is heard and always answered. Sometimes God will say, "NO" which we must accept. Most times God gives us what we need. **WHY DO YOU DOUBT HIS CALL? DO NOT BE AFRAID BUT BELIEVE. GET OUT OF THAT ROCKING BOAT AND INTO HIS SAVING ARMS..... FOR YOU ARE GREATLY LOVED!!!!**

NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: 1 Kings 19:9a, 11-13a

After fleeing from the revenge of the King of Israel, Elijah hid in a cave, but at the command of God, he went outside and stood on a mountain. There the Lord came to him, not in the wind nor in the earthquake, but in a "tiny whispering sound."

Second Reading: Romans 9:1-5

Paul is deeply pained because the Jews - despite everything that has been given to them - have rejected Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 14:22-33

Matthew vividly recounts the event of Jesus walking on the water. When the disciples see this, they are terrified, and Jesus chastises them for their fear. Peter begs Christ to let him walk on the water; he is at first brave but begins to sink and loses faith, crying out, "Lord save me!" Christ rescues him for his faltering faith.
