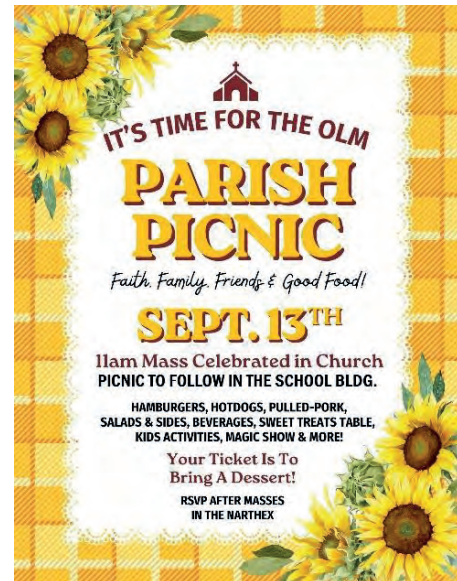

"STEP INTO..."

Today's readings dare to ask the question "what is the cost of following God and His Commandments?" In our first reading, the Prophet Jeremiah laments that he is paying a high price for doing the Lord's work. He warns the Israelites of the grave danger that will befall them if they do not repent and return to the ways of the Lord. He complains to God that the rejection and derision is too much for him to endure. The fire of the Lord's love burning in his heart cannot be contained, so he accepts his suffering. His fidelity to God remains to the end, but it cost him. Does loving the Lord, keeping His Commandments, and sharing your faith bring you ridicule and rejection? Saint Paul addresses this when he tells you, "do not conform yourselves to this age but be transformed by the will of God, which is good, pleasing and perfect." In today's gospel, Jesus confirms this teaching when He says, "whoever wishes to follow me must deny himself and take up his cross. Whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for MY sake will gain it. What profit is there for one to gain the whole world but lose their life?" You may be thinking; "why suffer, what's in it for me?" Let Jesus answer you, "the Son of Man will come in glory with His angels and repay you according to your conduct." **WILL YOU STEP INTO OUR LORD'S PASSION..... SO YOU WILL SHARE IN HIS GLORY???**

LOVE - that our children are filled with the love of God and know how deeply they are loved, and that love will overflow onto others.

TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Jeremiah 20:7-9

In this particularly poetic passage, Jeremiah complains that while teaching the Lord's word, he is subjected to insults and derision. He determines to remain silent, but he cannot because the desire to speak the Lord's name is "like a fire burning in my heart."

Second Reading: Romans 12:1-2

Paul tells the Christians to make sacrifices to avoid the trappings of the times, and to do God's will.

Gospel: Matthew 16:21-27

Jesus tries to make his disciples realize that by following him, they will endure suffering, degradation, and death. He tells them that they must deny themselves and take up the cross in order to be his disciples.
