## Confirmation: Needed For?

In my years as a Catholic, I have heard a lot of misinformation about the necessity of the Sacrament of Confirmation. For instance, I was told you could not get married without being Confirmed. False. Canon 1065 §1 states that one should be Confirmed before marriage, “if it can be done without grave inconvenience.” However, if a person is not confirmed or even if they refuse to be Confirmed, this is not an impediment to marriage. Although, if they refuse, then there may be the need for the priest to enquire why they want to be married in the Church and yet not be a fully initiated member of the Church? Fair enough.

So, is Confirmation required for anything? Indeed, it is. Canon 241 §2 states that reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation is necessary before the reception of Holy Orders and before one can be admitted to the seminary. Slightly redundant, canon 1050 §3 requires documentary evidence of Confirmation before reception of the Order of the Diaconate. So, we see that the Sacrament of Confirmation must be received before one can be ordained.

Similarly, canon 645 §1 states that the Sacrament of Confirmation must be received before one can enter the stage of formation called “novitiate” in religious life. Interestingly enough, unlike with entry into the seminary, one can enter formation for the religious life before having received the Sacrament of Confirmation because the novitiate does not occur until after a minimum of one year as an aspirant and one year as a postulant.

The Sacrament of Confirmation is required for living in the consecrated state of life and Holy Orders. Although the Sacrament of Confirmation is not required for the Sacrament of Marriage or the single lay state of life, there is no doubt that this sacrament magnifies one’s baptism, bestows and seals them with the sevenfold gifts of the Holy Spirit, and makes the recipient ready to serve the Church as a missionary and evangelist, defender and diffuser of the faith! In this day, who is strong enough in virtue to go through this life without the strength of the Holy Spirit?

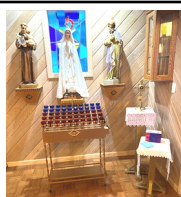

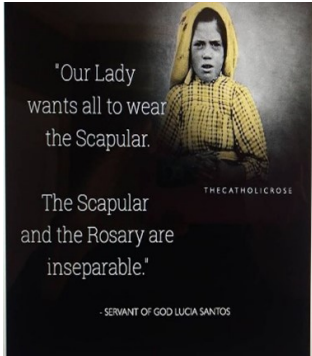

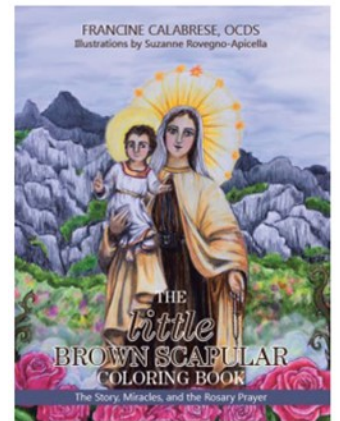
**Lucia saw additional visions** representing the mysteries of the **Rosary; Our Lady of Mt. Carmel** represented the Glorious mysteries.

**The last appearance of Our Lady** to Bernadette Soubirous was on the feast of **Our Lady of Mt. Carmel**.

**Our Lady of Good Help** – October 1859 (The **only** approved apparitions in the US, Champion, WI, was on Dec. 8, 2010 The Feast of the Immaculate Conception.) Our Lady asked Adele Brise in these apparitions to teach children what they should know about salvation.

**The *little* Brown Scapular Coloring Book, The Story, Miracles and the Rosary Prayer** will teach children about the Brown Scapular and the benefits received by wearing it. In addition, children will learn how to pray the Holy Rosary Prayer. The Brown Scapular is Our Lady's garment and protection, and St. Padre Pio called the Rosary, "the weapon".

Each book includes a children's size Brown Scapular and a Glow in the Dark Rosary. **The *little* Brown Scapular Apostolate, Inc. is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that was formed to spread the devotion of the Brown Scapular to parishes, Catholic schools and anyone who has a heart for Jesus and the Blessed Mother. ## **Food Truck & Live Music Festival: Saturday, June 5, 2021**

As Father Phil has announced, we are excited about a brand new fundraising event, the 2021 Branchville Food Truck Festival scheduled for June 5, 2021 from 11:30am until 8:30pm.

The event will include: 7-10 food trucks, Vendor Sponsorships, Wine Tasting and Beer Tents, OLQP Food Tables, 3-4 Bands Performing, Craft Vendors, Horseback Rides and or Petting Zoo and activities to make for a fun day for everyone and more to come. We anticipate 1000 participants. We are in the process of creating a separate website, to market all our fundraising events now and in the future which will link to OLQP website. This also gives us an opportunity to use the site to attract sponsorships. In addition, we will identify another nonprofit company/agency in which we will donate a portion of our event profits.

We have a great deal of work to do in the next 4 months and we need everyone's help. This event will kick-off the summer and we CANNOT be successful without the help of all our parishioners and all their networks. We need each person to reach out to family, friends, neighbors, business partners and coworkers to participate in our event. To start we have to get major sponsorships for all items that will be a cost/expense to the event such as entertainment, marketing, safety and security, land usage requirements and administrative costs. When talking to potential sponsors remember to invite them to join this great event that will be an opportunity in marketing their own company verses begging for help. This event when done properly will benefit everyone who attends. So how can you help... get involved. Volunteer on committees utilizing your experience, expertise or interests. Committees will include: Financial, Marketing, Sponsorships, Vendors, Ticket and 50/50 sales, OLQP Food Sales, Safety and Security, Event Day administration and Coordination, Entertainment and more.

Keep in mind the day of the event we will also need approximately 40 volunteers for the day of the event. We will need volunteers to be available for at least 5 hour shifts to cover the day's event including set up and clean up.

So let's get started:

### **Phase I:**

Identify and Obtain all appropriate licenses and permits for Food Trucks. Secure participation of our Major Sponsorships and Large Vendors by February 28<sup>th</sup>. Sponsorship, Vendors and Volunteer Forms and applications are in the back of the church and eventually will be on our website to complete on line as well pay online.

### **Phase II:**

Continue to receive vendors, sponsorships and donations. Mass marketing of our event using radio, social media, flyers...Sell Admission Tickets, Sell 50/50 Tickets from March 1<sup>st</sup> thru June 5<sup>th</sup>.

Design a map of our property and how we are going to design the layout of the event: parking and traffic flow, fencing off property, food trucks, stage, vendor tables, beer tent and wine tasting tent. Entrance and exit to ensure only ticket holders are inside.

Financial processes and procedures to protect and ensure accuracy of all funds collected during the event.

Safety and security processes and procedures in coordination with onsite police, EMT assistance...
