


# Catholic in Recovery

## Ask the Pastor

### Salvation of Infants Who Die in the Womb

**Question:** Is it possible to Baptize an unborn baby? I consider this in light of miscarriages and abortions - how do we take care of their souls?


**Response:** For a comprehensive treatment of this question, I refer you to the document of the *International Theological Commission* of the then-Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith: *La Speranza della Salvezza per i Bambini che Muoiono Senza Battesimo (The Hope of Salvation for Infants that Die Without Baptism)*, which was promulgated in 2007. In short, there is abundant hope in the mercy of God and, while all salvation is mediated by Jesus Christ alone and connected to the Church, Baptism, and the Eucharist, it is possible for a child to still be saved.

However, I offer the following for reflection: if the parents of the child desire Baptism does that supplied desire suffice for the Baptism of Desire which is sufficient for the reception of the grace of Baptism? After all, an infant that has been baptized but has not yet reached the age of reason and then tragically dies has not expressed the desire themselves for Christ although they are still considered as having been saved by their infant Baptism.

Furthermore, during a pregnancy the mother is providing direct sustenance to the child, if that mother is Catholic and practicing then she would be regularly receiving the Eucharist; therefore, the child in the womb would also be receiving the Eucharist.

The Church always recognizes mercy toward those who were murdered before they were able to repent of any sins, profess faith, etc. Abortion is murder. Therefore, the child murdered in their mother's womb would be the object of divine mercy.

Lastly, the Church has a special Mass setting for still born babies to have a proper Funeral Mass and Christian burial. I will go you a step further, we also celebrate Mass for aborted babies all the time and I have offered private masses, for the sake of discretion, for parents who have had abortions. One such couple came to me after being told they would never be able to conceive because of the damage done to her uterine wall from having had an abortion. I offered a votive Mass of the Precious Blood and laid hands on the couple. Nine months later they gave birth to twins that I had the privilege of baptizing.

## Fr. Krzysztof's Divine Mercy Page

During the life of Sister Faustina, who died in 1938, the first pictures printed of the painting of Merciful Jesus from Vilnius were reproductions of the original painting. During the Second World War they were taken by soldiers, refugees, and exiles, and in this way the image of Merciful Jesus spread all over the world. Also, after the Second World War, the cult of Divine Mercy given by Sister Faustina developed intensively.

We can say it was a new and very spontaneous cult, and therefore without theological foundation and with distortions. This cult and the "Diary" of Sister Faustina, incorrectly copied from the original and incorrectly translated, caused, in 1959, the Apostolic See to forbid the worship of Divine Mercy in the forms given by Sister Faustina Kowalska.

The ban was not lifted until April 1978 thanks to the efforts of the Archbishop of Krakow - Karol Wojtyla. Half a year later, now a Cardinal, Karol Wojtyla became Pope John Paul II. He was strongly convinced of the truthfulness of all the messages of God's mercy.

From that moment on, Pope John Paul II, proclaimed the worship of God's mercy in the universal Church. He said that the task that God set before his pontificate was to preach the message of God's Mercy. John Paul II was named the Pope of Divine Mercy due to what he did for the development of the cult. Along with others, he beatified Sister Faustina in 1993 and canonized her in 2000. He entrusted the whole world to God's mercy in Lagiewniki, Poland in 2002 in Sanctuary of Divine Mercy.

Sister Faustina's Diary is now the most translated and published Polish text in the world.





## REFLECT

While we often think of pregnancy as culminating in the birth of child, we know that the journey is only just beginning. While motherhood brings with it many joys and blessings, it also involves challenges and difficulties. In raising their children and dedicating themselves to their families, mothers participate in a type of “daily heroism,” one for which they “do not always find support in the world around them” (EV 86). Providing and caring for children as a single mother includes additional hardships. Sadly, today, one in four children are being raised without a father. Certainly, there are many reasons this might occur in any given circumstance. However, it is also true that in a culture that largely rejects the Church’s teachings on marriage, life, and sexuality, women and their children are often disproportionately impacted. It was Pope Paul VI in *Humanae vitae* who warned that, “a man who grows accustomed to the use of contraceptive methods may forget the reverence due to a woman... no longer considering her as his partner whom he should surround with care and affection” (HV 17).

In the midst of this reality, the Church is called to be a beacon of light, hope, and support. May we respond to this call, individually and communally, to surround mothers with assistance and support as they lovingly care for their children.

## ACT (choose one)

- Saints Anne and Joachim—whose feast is celebrated on July 26—were the parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Parents often seek the intercession of these married saints as they raise their own children. Offer this prayer ([bit.ly/anne-joachim](http://bit.ly/anne-joachim)), asking Saints Anne and Joachim to pray for the featured intention.
- Fast from television, social media, music, or electronics altogether for one day. Ask the Lord to use the quiet and stillness to bring you more closely to Him.
- Offer some other sacrifice, prayer, or act of penance that you feel called to do for the featured intention.






